

## Supplemental Educational Services

The Raymond School District is offering free remedial tutoring in reading and math for selected students in grades K-12. Eligibility is determined by academic need and family income level. Lessons can take place before school, after school, or on weekends. They may be conducted at school, off-site, at home, or via the internet. Parents are given a list of state-approved providers from which to choose. Tutoring services are free to families. They are paid for by the district using federal Title I (“No Child Left Behind”) funds. The chart below offers a profile of our program since fall, 2007:
