SAT and ACT Test Dates and Deadlines

January 28th SAT – register by Dec. 30th

February 11th ACT – register by Jan.13th

March 10th SAT – register by Feb. 10th

April 14th ACT – register by March 9th

May 5th SAT – register by April 6th

June 2nd SAT – register by May 8th

June 9th ACT – register by May 4th
