

**RAYMOND SCHOOL DISTRICT

TO THE INHABITANTS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, IN THE TOWN OF RAYMOND, NEW HAMPSHIRE, QUALIFIED TO VOTE IN DISTRICT AFFAIRS:

FIRST SESSION

You are hereby notified to meet at Raymond High School Cafetorium in said District, on Saturday, the **30th** day of **January, 2010, at 10:00 AM in the morning**. This session shall consist of explanation, discussion and deliberation of the warrant articles numbered **2** through **5**. The warrant articles may be amended subject to the following limitations: (a) warrant articles whose wording is prescribed by law shall not be amended, and (b) warrant articles that are amended shall be placed on the official ballot for a final vote on the main motion as amended.

SECOND SESSION

Voting Session to act on all Warrant Articles as amended, including the proposed budget, as a result of the action of the "FIRST SESSION" will be held Tuesday, March 9, 2010, at the Iber Holmes Gove Middle School Gymnasium. Polls will be open from 7:00 AM - 7:00 PM.

1) Article 1, Election of Officers

To choose the following School District Officers:

a.) To choose two School Board Members for the ensuing three years.

2) Shall the School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant, or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$21,978,341 (*Twenty One Million, Nine Hundred Seventy Eight Thousand, Three Hundred Forty One Dollars*)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$22,296,956 (*Twenty Two Million, Two Hundred Ninety Six Thousand, Nine Hundred Fifty Six Dollars*) which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Raymond School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. (This article does not include appropriations proposed under any other warrant article.)

3) Shall the School District vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Raymond School Board and the Raymond Education Association, which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing levels:

<u>Year</u>	<u>Estimated Increase</u>
2010-2011	\$128,638
2011-2012	\$173,282

and further to raise and appropriate the sum of \$128,638 (One Hundred Twenty Eight Thousand, Six Hundred Thirty Eight Dollars) for the upcoming fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels in accordance with the most recent collective bargaining agreement? (Recommended by the School Board) (Recommended by the Budget Committee)

Note: Pursuant to RSA 273-A:12, if approved, the terms of this collective bargaining agreement, including the pay plan, but excluding cost of living increases, will continue in force and effect until a new agreement is executed.

4) Shall the School District, if article 3 is defeated, authorize the governing body to call one special meeting, at its option, to address article 3 cost items only?

5) Shall the School District vote to raise and appropriate the following sums (\$221,997) in total to be placed in the following previously established Capital Reserve Funds to implement the School District's 2010-2011 Capital Improvement Program?

Raymond School District Equipment, Facilities Maintenance and Replacement Capital Reserve Fund.....	\$144,032
Raymond School District Food Service Equipment Capital Reserve Fund..	\$ 13,565
Technology Capital Reserve Fund.....	\$ 30,000
Textbook Capital Reserve Fund.....	\$ 34,400
Total	<u>\$221,997</u>
