

## Raymond School District Policy - IOE

### ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL PROGRAMS

The Raymond School Board recognizes that some students have specific individual needs that may require alternative arrangements to meet the requirements of a high school diploma as specified by the Standards for Approval of New Hampshire Public High Schools and the policy of the Raymond School Board.

In an effort to eliminate the risk that some of our youth will opt to leave the school system prior to graduation due to individual needs that do not conform to the normal school program, the Board approves of the development of an individually tailored student program. Request for an individual alternative program is to be presented to the building Principal by the student and/or parent/guardian. The program must be based on meeting the minimum requirements established by the state for the awarding of a high school diploma while allowing appropriate flexibility for the student.

Procedures for the development, implementation, and monitoring of the program are to be worked out by the school administration and the Superintendent.
