

Raymond High School Summer School Program 2017

The Raymond High School Summer School Program is designed to provide credit recovery for high school students. Freshmen or sophomores are eligible to take direct instruction in English, Math, Science, & Social Studies.

Juniors and seniors needing a course for credit recovery may only take a course via PLATO based upon space availability; first come, first served basis.

Eligibility:

Raymond students who are currently enrolled in grades 9-11 are eligible.

Enrichment:

Students wishing to take classes for enrichment purposes may do so with written permission from the program coordinator/administration.

Admission Policy:

Students are accepted and courses are assigned in the order in which applications are received for all programs. Enrollment is limited.

Courses Offered:

Math, English, Science, Social Studies & PLATO.

Cost: \$150.00 per course.

Faculty:

Certified teachers will be teaching credit courses.

Attendance:

Consistent attendance is required. Any absence will impact a student's ability to pass a course. Students who have more than two absences during the session **will not** earn credit and will be withdrawn from the program. Tardiness of ten minutes or more counts as one absence; three tardies of less than ten minutes will add up to one absence.

Grade Reports:

Grade reports for credit courses will be issued at the end of the second week and at the end of the course. Raymond High School uses a formula to determine the grade that will appear on a student's transcript; please refer to page 16 of the RHS Student Handbook for this formula. Upon completion of the course, the final grade is mailed to students and transferred to the high school guidance office where it will be officially recorded.
