LEAP Registration

As we prepare to kick off the 2020-2021 school year, I am excited to announce that LEAP will be back in person! We are open to students every day they are in the buildings for learning and have plenty of spots still available at both LRES and IHGMS.

Because of the conditions in the reopening plan there are some changes that you need to be aware of. The first, and most important change, is our hours. Until further notice, both programs will close promptly at 5:00. This is to allow custodians the time they need to disinfect the areas we use so that they are ready for the next school day.

The other change is in our fee structure. Since kids can only attend on days that they are in the building for learning, we have reduced our rates at LRES by 50% while we are in this model. The rate for IHGMS remains a one time fee of \$50 for the entire year (still a great deal!). Other than that, we will be the same LEAP we've always been and hope you consider joining us!
