### DIABETIC SUPPLY LIST

The following checklist is provided as a reference to ensure your student has the supplies needed in the Health Office in case of a diabetic emergency. **ALL** supplies must be brought to the health office. ***Please send your student with these items that are applicable on the first day of school:***

- ☐ Diabetic Care Plan- Signed by provider
- ☐ Permission to monitor blood glucose via Dexcom (if applicable)
- ☐ Unopened Insulin (for pump) or Extra Insulin Pen
- ☐ Pump or Pod supplies, Syringes (for pump emergencies) or Pen Needles
- ☐ Glucagon/Baqsimi (rescue medication)
- ☐ Glucometer kit / Ketone Strips (blood or urine)
- ☐ Glucose tablets, Snacks (juice boxes, cheese or PB crackers, granola bars, etc.)

#### **Diabetic Care Plan:**

This will include orders, treatments & action plan from your provider. If applicable the nurse will monitor CGM (continuous glucose management) via Dexcom during school hours.

**The Health Office does NOT have a glucometer to loan.** Your student **MUST** store a personal glucometer in the office, regardless if they carry one on their person, in case of emergency.
