Summer ELO Reflection Paper

Reflection Paper Guidelines

The reflection paper is a requirement for students participating in an ELO over the summer. The paper will replace the Google Classroom journal assignments. This is a reflection of your summer ELO experiences and can include any observations, pros and cons of your experience, favorite parts, criticisms and any recommendations you'd like to share. The paper is due along with your project at the time of your presentation in the fall.

The paper should be typed, and a minimum of 2 pages. Please make sure you include your name, current date and name of your ELO.

Some examples of reflection questions to include in your paper may be:

- The reason why you wanted to do your ELO over the summer?
- What activities did you participate in and how did they go?
- Did you feel as though you answered your essential question?
- What worked and what didn't work during your ELO? Any particular challenges?
- What would you do differently if you were to do this again?
- What is difficult to manage other commitments while in involved in an ELO?
- What new skills did you learn from your summer experience?
