EVALUATION OF THE BOARD

At the conclusion of each year, the board shall evaluate its own performance in terms of generally accepted principles of successful board operations and in relation to its annual goals and objectives. The Superintendent will present his/her evaluation of the Board's performance, for board member consideration in the self-evaluation. The board self-evaluation shall address performance in the key functions of school boards - vision, structure, accountability, advocacy, and unity. The results of the self-evaluation shall be used in setting goals for the subsequent year.
