ANNUALLY

- Number of Teachers
- Number of Administrators
- Number of Support Personnel
- Class size Analysis
- Results of any State Assessments
- Results of other standardized assessments as adopted by the School District
i.e. SAT, NWEA

ONGOING

- Police Reports ("Police Reports" refers to incident reports that are reported to Raymond Police Department – beyond the School Resource Officer)

Upon receiving reports, the School Board will take steps to reach the goals of the School District.
