ARTICLE 5 Shall the School District vote to authorize the School Board to enter into a multi-year lease purchase agreement for the installation of up to \$1,743,064 (one million, seven hundred forty-three thousand, sixty-four dollars) of energy saving equipment and associated building and facility improvements at Raymond High School and Iber Holmes Gove Middle School, and further to raise and appropriate \$125,216 (one hundred twenty-five thousand, two hundred sixteen dollars) for annual lease payments to be partially offset by energy savings and a resulting reduction in costs? This lease agreement will contain a non-appropriation clause. Lease payments in future years will be \$125,216 (one hundred twenty-five thousand, two hundred sixteen dollars), guaranteed energy savings will be \$65,738 (sixty-five thousand, seven hundred thirty-eight dollars), so the estimated future budget impact, if this article passes is \$59,478 (fifty-nine thousand, four hundred seventy-eight dollars).
