*To consider the following expenditures of funds: Up to a total of \$95,000 from the Equipment, Facilities Maintenance and Replacement Capital Reserve Fund to upgrade two bathrooms at Lamprey River Elementary School and for two safety projects at Iber Holmes Gove Middle School; Up to \$25,000 from the Technology Capital Reserve Fund to upgrade the District’s firewall and purchase three I.D. card printers; The balance (approximately \$16,000) in the Textbook Capital Reserve Fund to purchase science kits for Lamprey River Elementary School.*
