In considering the needs of our pre-K to grade 12 students, and our current facilities utilization, it is my determination that it would be best for our students and the District to move grade 4 to IHGMS and move the preschool program to RHS. However, it has been made clear through iterative Board discussions that the removal of the portable classrooms at LRES would be required as part of such a move. That being the case, the two moves (preschool and grade 4) must take place simultaneously to prevent any adverse impact on students in grades K-3. We could make this occur by next fall if necessary., However, if both moves occur in the summer of 2021, there would be more time for planning and preparation for these important changes (including renovations, master schedule changes, potential curriculum adjustments and more specific budget development for fiscal year 2022).
