

Principal's Opening Day Report to the Raymond School Board

<p>Overview and Acknowledgements</p>	<p>RHS has had a smooth first quarter of the 2023/24 school year.</p> <p>Athletics: We have piloted / are piloting two new athletic programs: Fall Spirit and our new athletic study hall (starting this winter season). Student-athletes will be able to more effectively manage their schedules, improve time management skills, and help reduce their stress. Additionally, this initiative will do more to ensure all student-athletes remain eligible for the season. Finally, two of our fall sports teams qualified for the NHIAA tournament and seven of our runners participated in the State meet.</p> <p>RAM: Students attend their scheduled RAM on Mondays to check in with their teacher, look at grades, create goals for the week, and help ensure the students schedule the appropriate teachers for extra help/reassessments. Students who are passing all of their classes are able to choose an enrichment activity on Friday's. Enrichment activities have included: fly fishing lure patterns, ultimate frisbee, chess, book lovers discussion groups, and bookmark making.</p> <p>Therapy Dog: This year we have incorporated the services of Benny, our RHS therapy dog. He is a six year old Shih Tzu, and as such, is hypoallergenic, meaning he has hair, not fur, which is good for people with allergies. Benny is owned by Ms. Trudel, the administrative assistant in the school counseling office. She has had Benny since he was a puppy and both are trained, certified and insured as a Therapy Dog Team by Alliance Therapy Dogs. Benny has worked with all populations from small children right through the elderly. We are working out a regular schedule to welcome Benny twice a week.</p> <p>NHS Inductions: Fourteen students were officially inducted into the National Honor Society on Tuesday, 11/14/23. Along with our nineteen returning members, our current number of NHS members is thirty-three. Congratulations to all new inductees as well as to our returning members.</p> <p>Vertical PD Day - Staff from the Middle and High School combined for a vertical workshop to review the most recent YRBS (March 2023) data with the RCFY in the hopes of identifying trends and tactics for countering these trends. Middle and high school administrators, along with district and RCFY will be reviewing the work completed by staff and proposing our next steps.</p> <p>Quarterly Honor Roll: We will once again be recognizing students at the end of each quarter for their academic achievement. Once grades are released for quarter one, we will identify those students</p>
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	<p>who achieved the honor roll and recognize them during a RAM block.</p> <p>Juniors PSAT: 50 students participated in the test. Scores should be released within the next few weeks.</p>																																								
<p>Transportation</p>	<p>No major concerns regarding transportation to & from school, SST programs. Currently our Athletic Director, Mr. Gaudet is working on scheduling buses for the winter athletic season.</p> <p>We did have paving going on at Old Manchester Rd.
