This issue was first brought to the attention of the School Board by Michelle Couture, who referenced a [letter written by Dover](#) and suggested that Raymond School Board write a similar letter. After some discussion, it was agreed to invite our representatives to a meeting to discuss the possible effects if [Senate Bill 193](#) were to become law.

Representative Hoelzel noted the following during my correspondence with her:

"Attached is the newest version of sb 193. It was amended and voted out of committee the week. The recommendation of the House Education Committee is "Ought to Pass". It will come to the full House in January . I would warn all to be aware that this is NOT a big cost item. I am sure there will be controversy but after sitting in for many hours of discussion on this bill, I can honestly say I think they got it right for the students and parents who need it. Please be sure that board members are aware that the PDF file attached is the final that will go to the floor of the House unless there is a floor amendment this is what will be voted upon. It is unlikely that a floor amendment that does much change will pass."

From NHSBA: The adoption of Senate Bill 43 by the Legislature in 2017 added a requirement for prior written consent from a parent or guardian before a non-academic survey can be administered. As a result, state law, RSA 186:11, IX-d, requirements are nearly identical to the requirements of the federal Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment. This update, therefore, combines sample policy ILD, Educational Questionnaires, Surveys, and Research with sample policy ILDA, Non-Educational Questionnaires, Surveys, and Research.
