Technology Director Kevin Federico will be at the meeting to update the Board on the work of the Technology Committee. From Kevin:

“The Technology Plan Committee has met four times over the past few months. We have made steady progress gathering information and evaluating where we stand technologically as a district. We have read and reviewed the 2014-17 Technology Plan and decided upon a method of updating the actual document.

“We reviewed the “Goals” section, and to the best of our knowledge answered the question, Have we completed this goal? Does this Goal need to be moved forward? Has this goal changed purpose in the last 4 years? Does this goal need to be updated?

“In the process of our review we unanimously agreed to reach out to Staff, Students, Parents, and the Community, to assess their thoughts and ideas of what we have and where we stand as a district.

“The committee created three surveys to obtain this information, [one for staff](#), [one for students](#) (5-12) and one for the [parents and community](#). We would like the Board to be fully informed regarding these surveys; we have established a two week collection time for respondents.”

Our ESL students in need of services have recently increased. The teacher contract is currently at 50% FTE and needs to increase to 65% FTE. This will increase salary by \$3,880.84 and increase benefits by \$296.88. Her ESL student count will go from one to two students, which results in the additional time needed. This teacher also teaches FACS part time.
