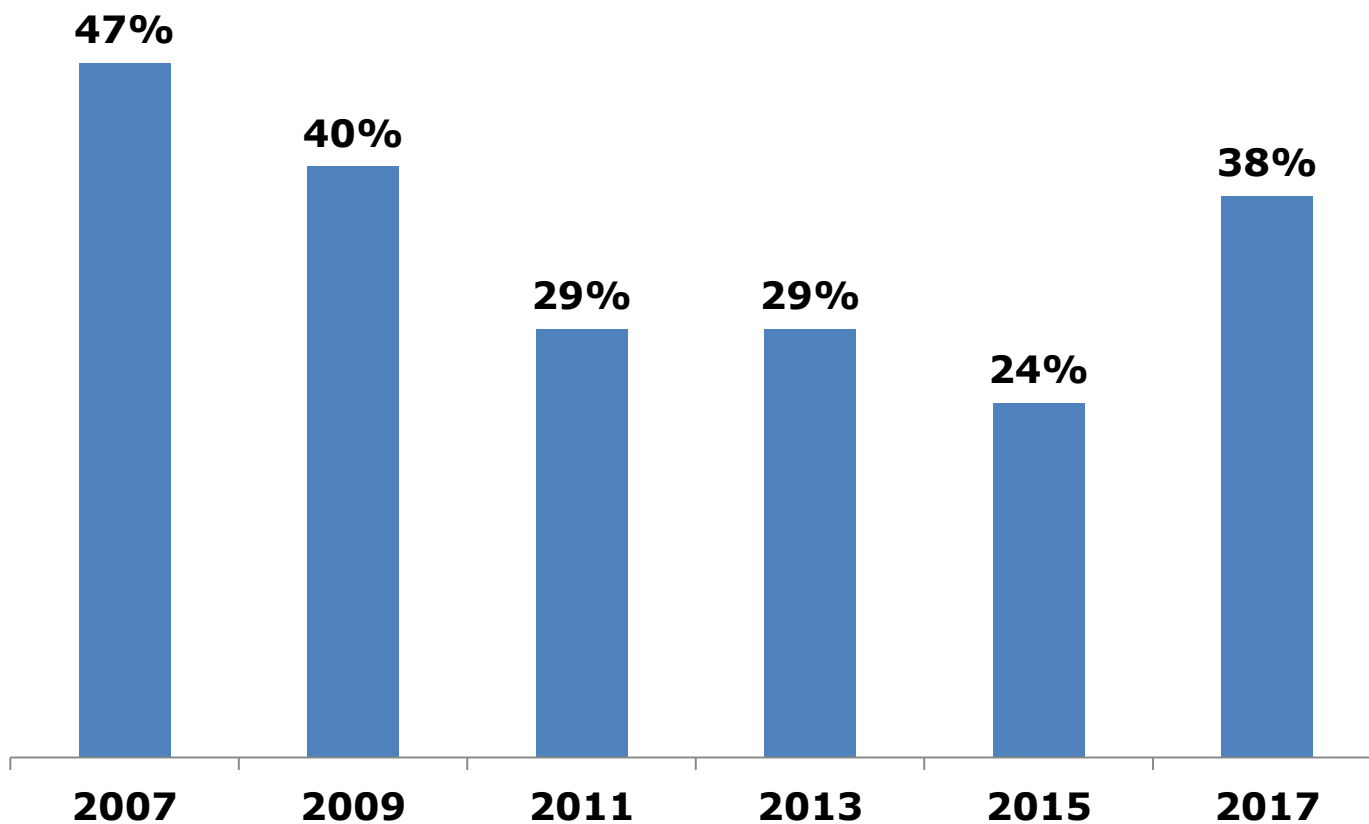

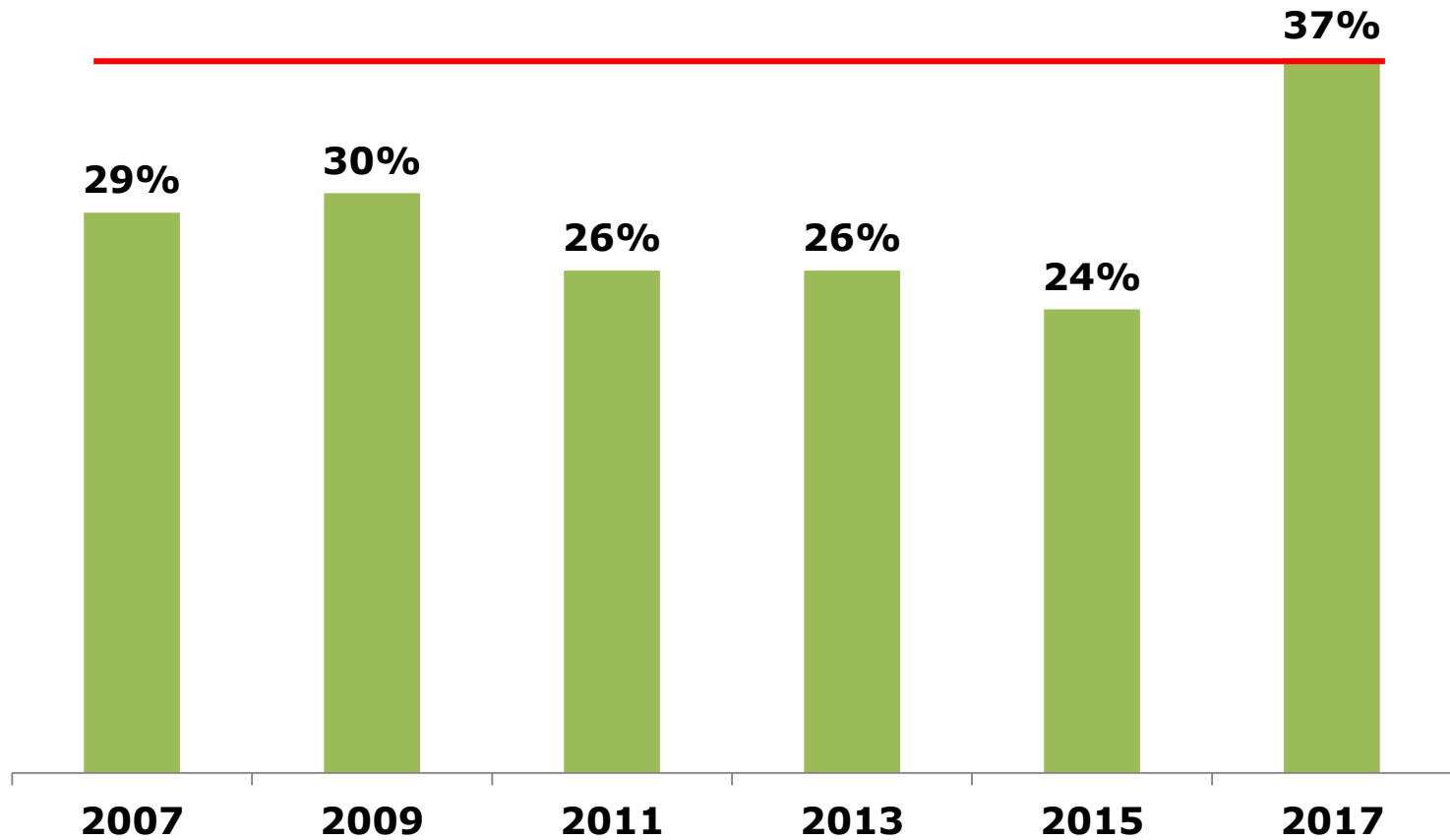
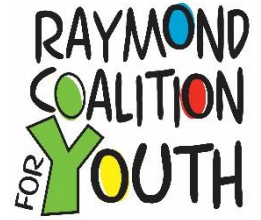


41% of students have USED a vape product (2017) (up 1%, 15)

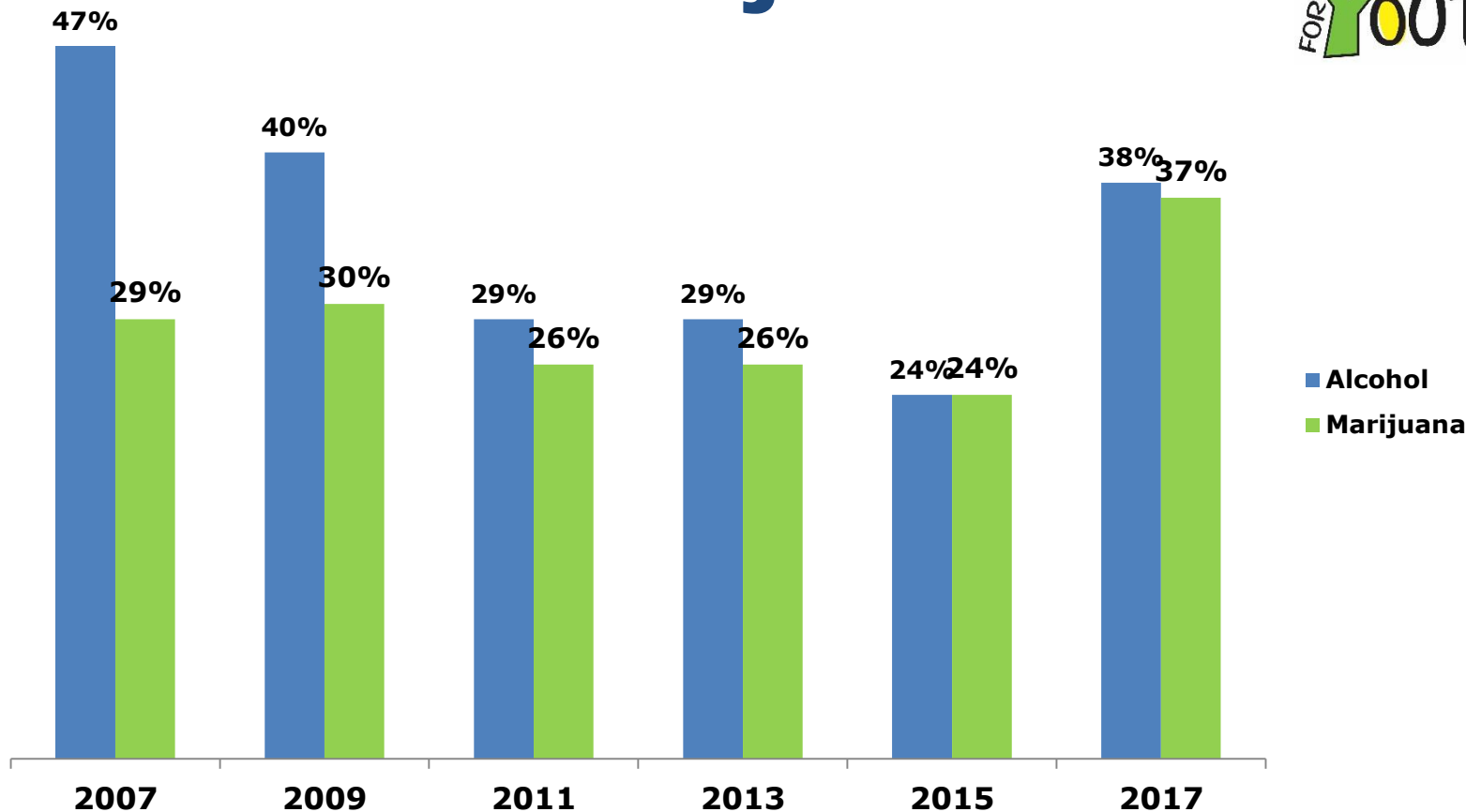
Past 30 day Alcohol use



Past 30 day Marijuana use



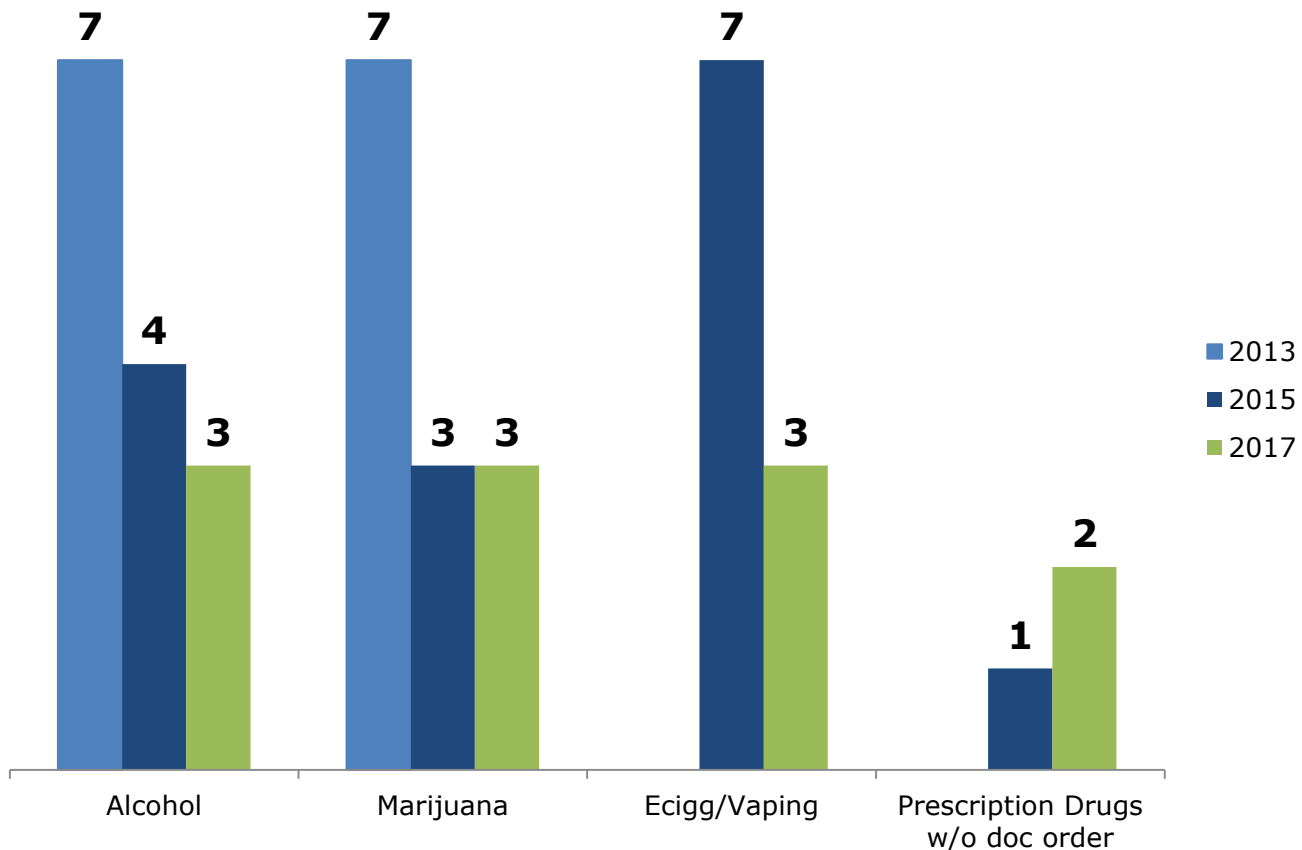
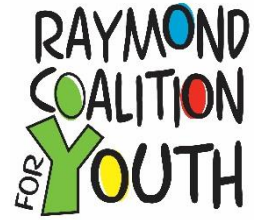
Alcohol and Marijuana Use



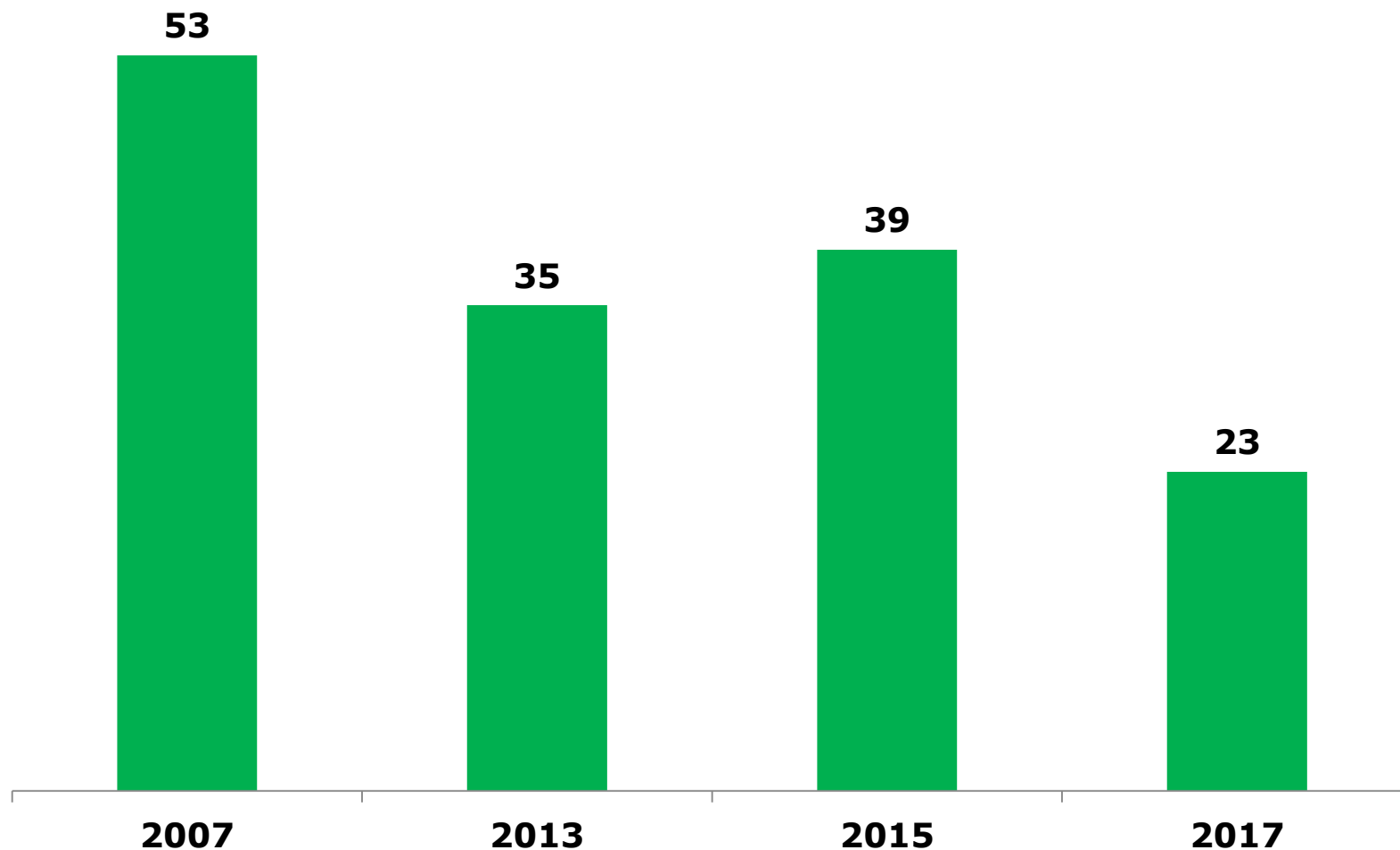
11% of Students report driving in a car with someone who had used **Alcohol**

28% of students have driven in a car with someone who has used **Marijuana**

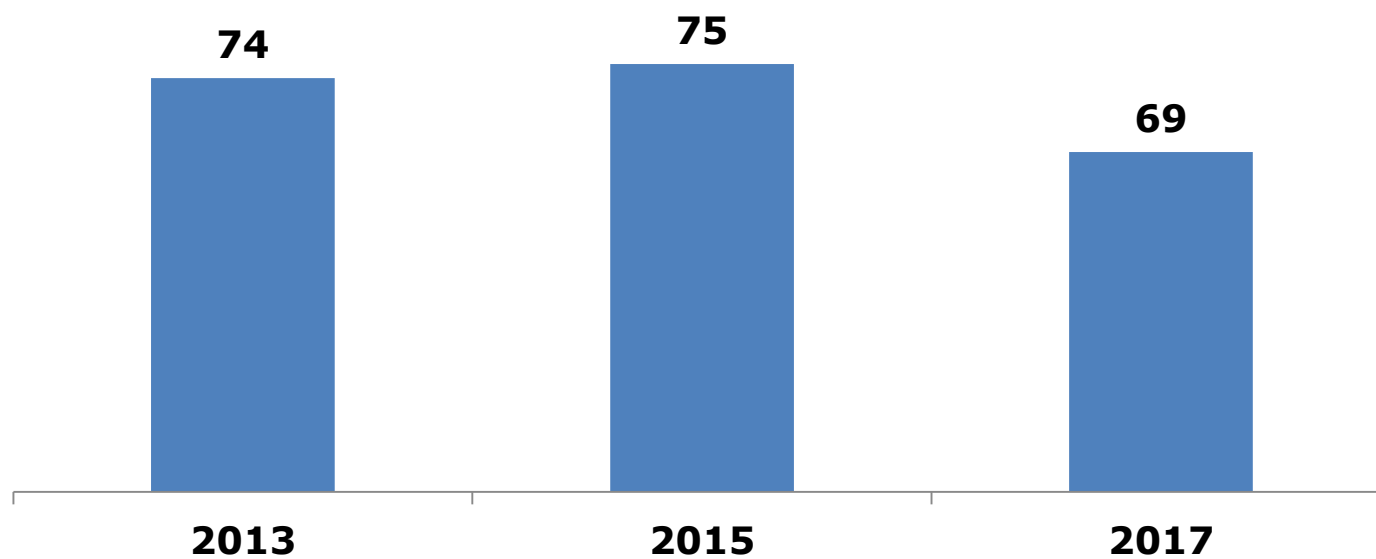
Past 30 day for MIDDLE SCHOOL, 6th – 8th grade



High School Students who believe Marijuana use is wrong or very wrong

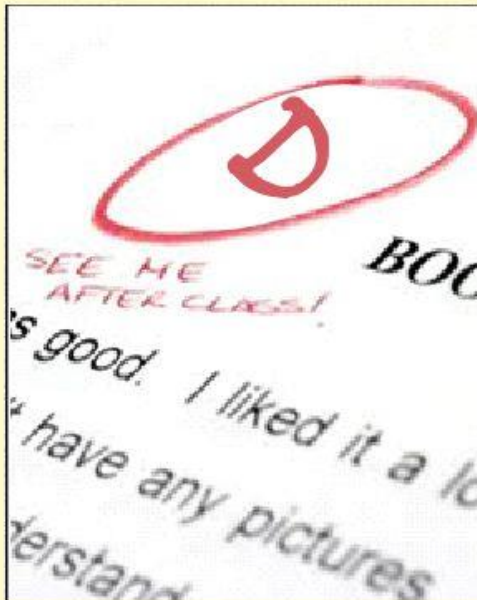


Middle School Students who believe Marijuana use is wrong or very wrong



Academic Performance

Marijuana Use



- **Negatively affects learning**

A teen who uses is 4 times more likely to report “D” grades.

SAMHSA

- **Is linked to higher dropout rates**

A teenage marijuana user is 2 times more likely to drop out of school than a non-user.

NIDA

Is Marijuana use associated with standardized test scores?

For each 5% increase in past 30 day prevalence of marijuana use at their school, students were:

12% less likely to meet math standards

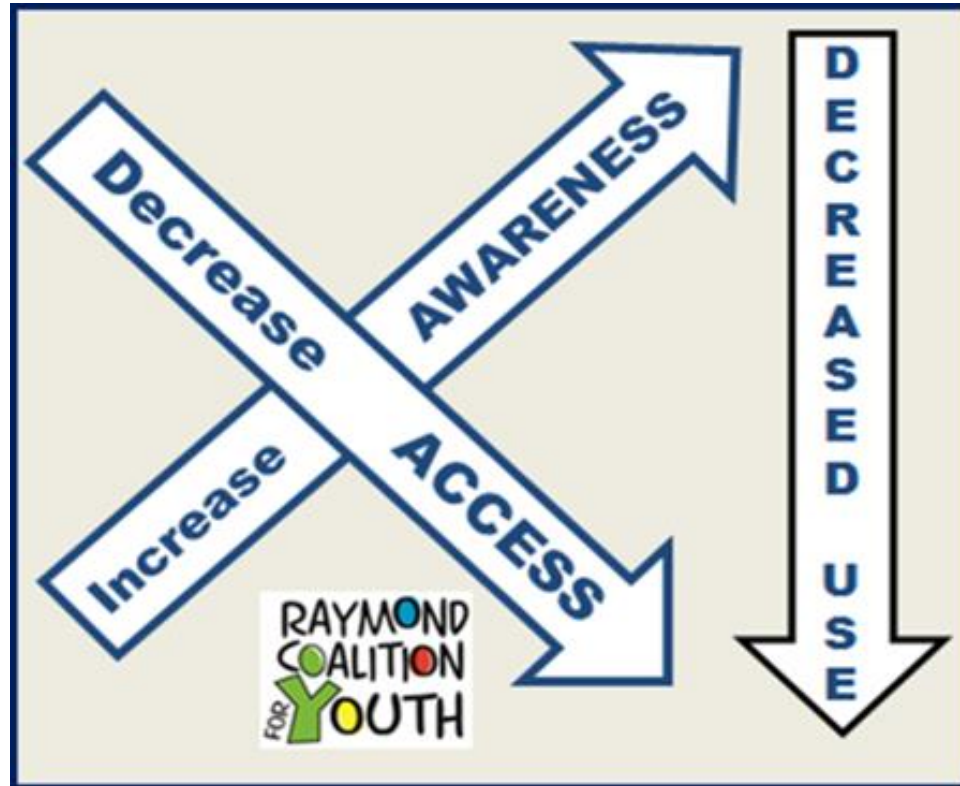
12% less likely to meet writing standards

9% less likely to meet reading standards

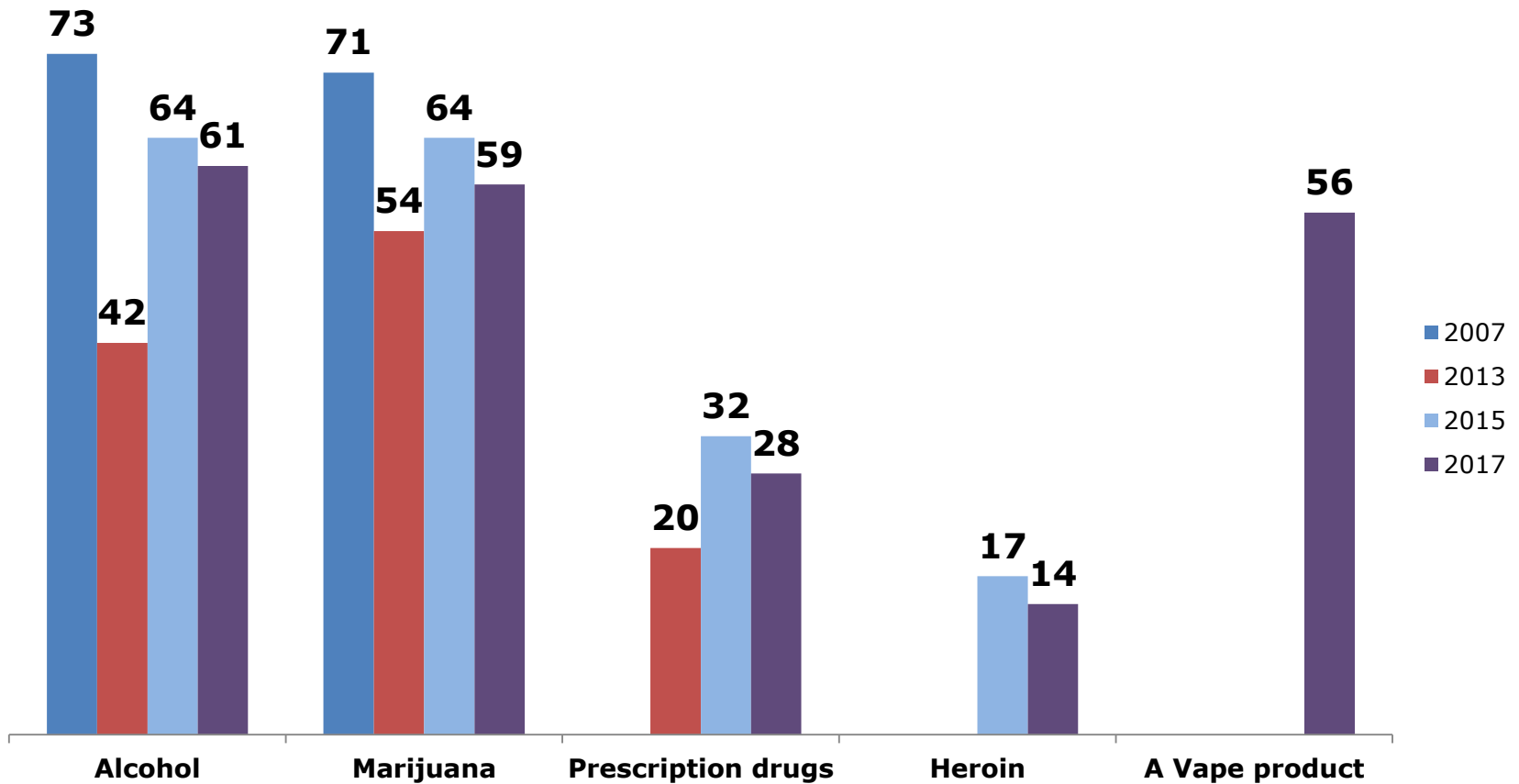

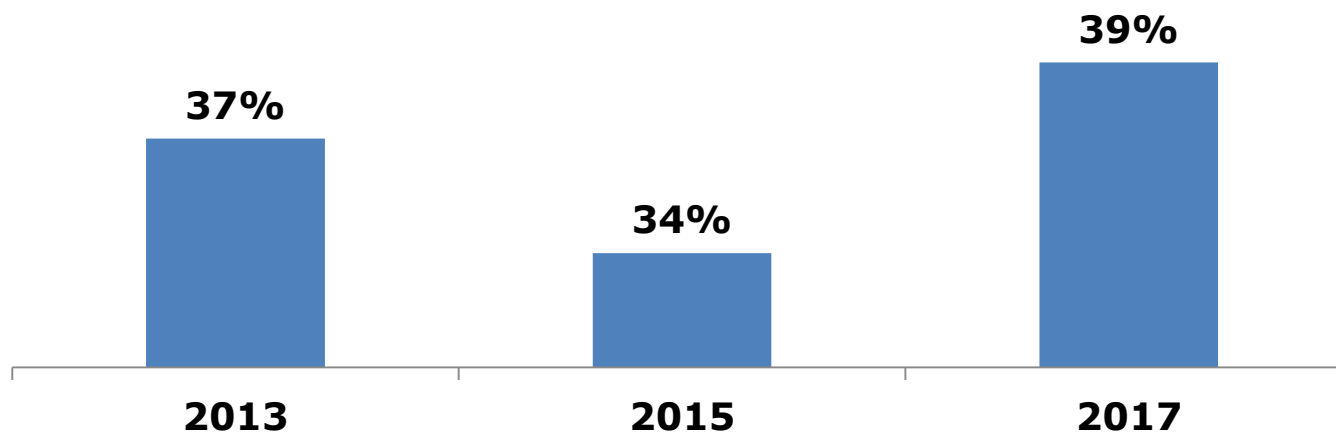

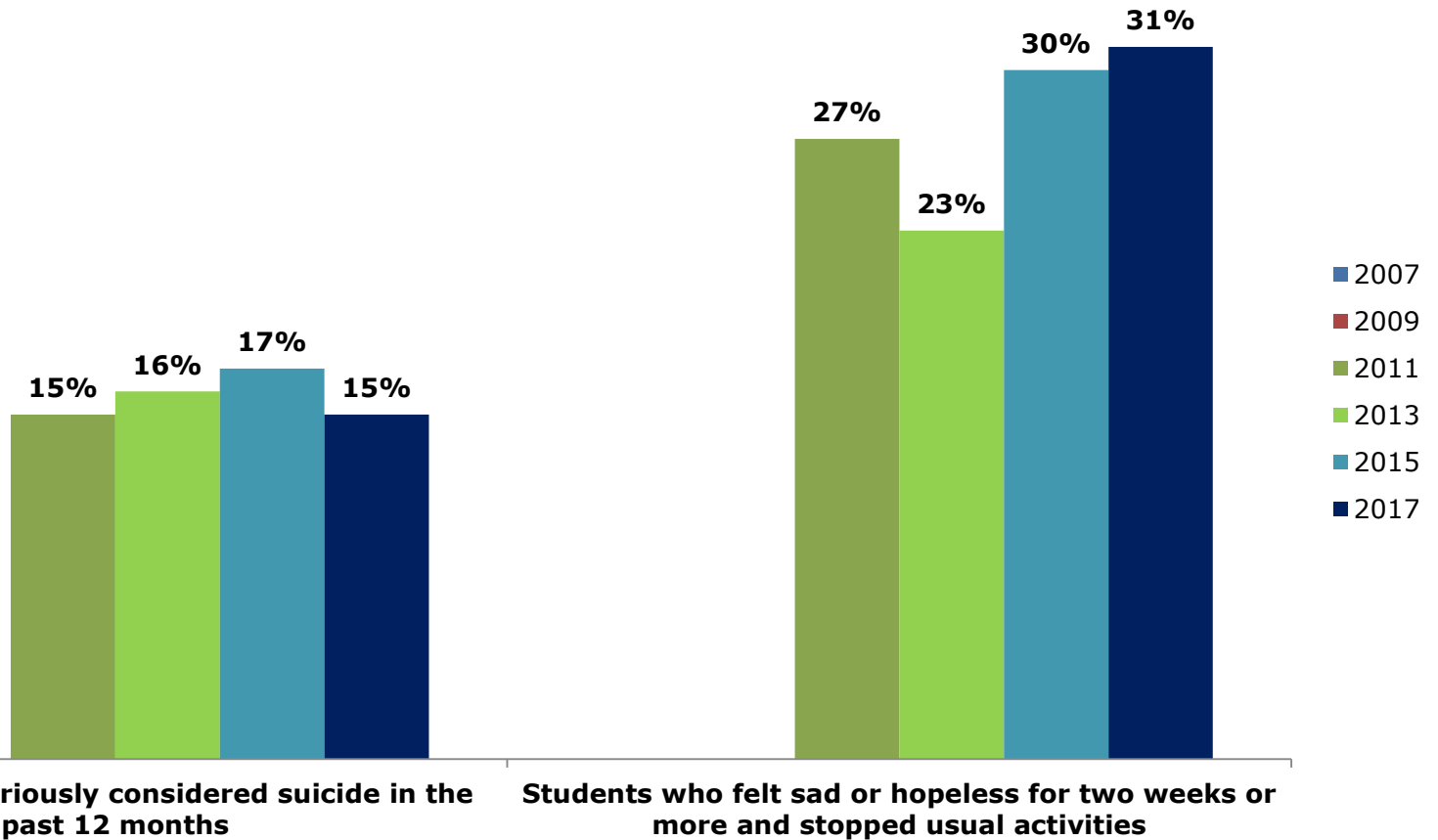

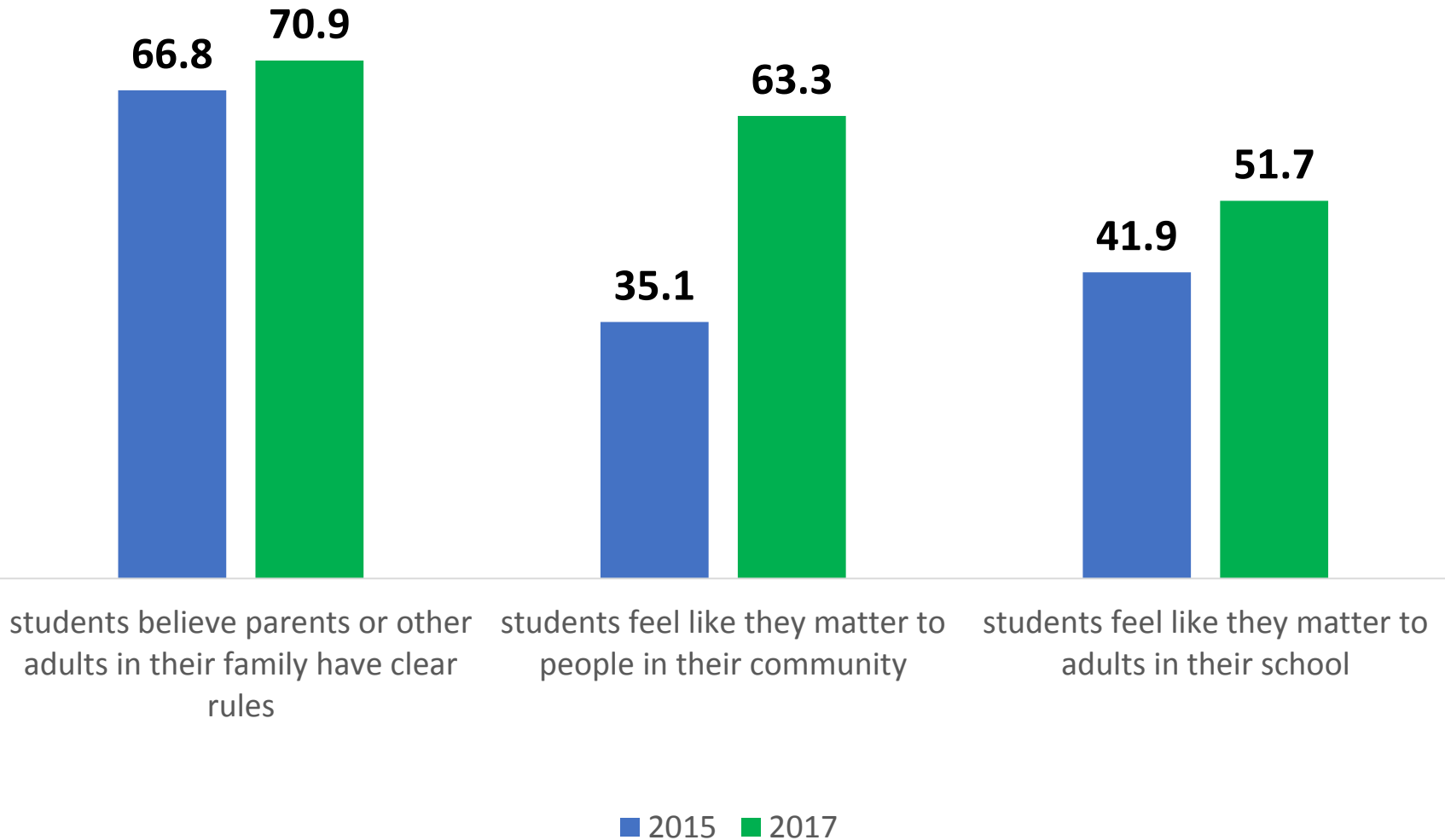

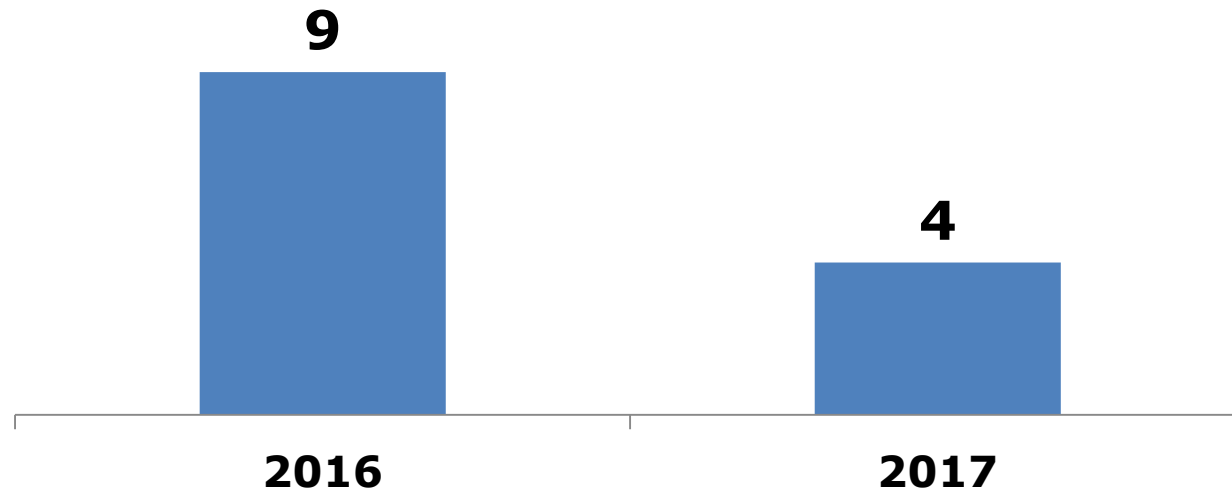
