

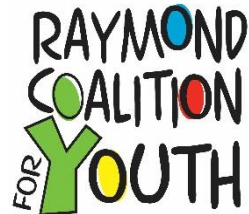

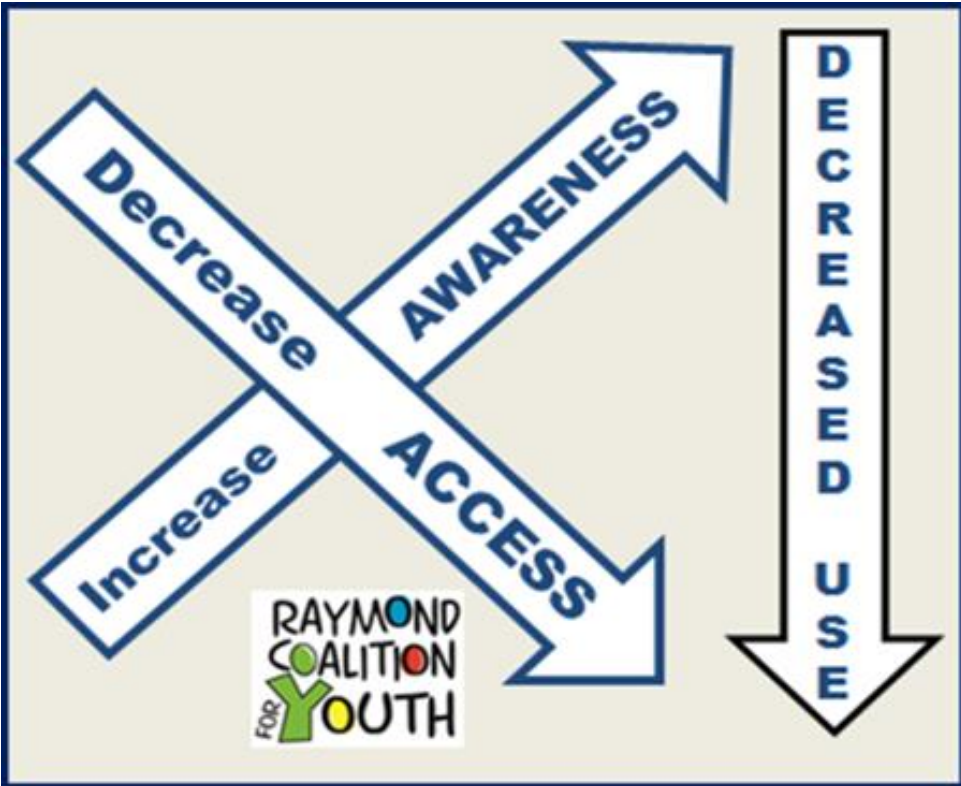

area.**

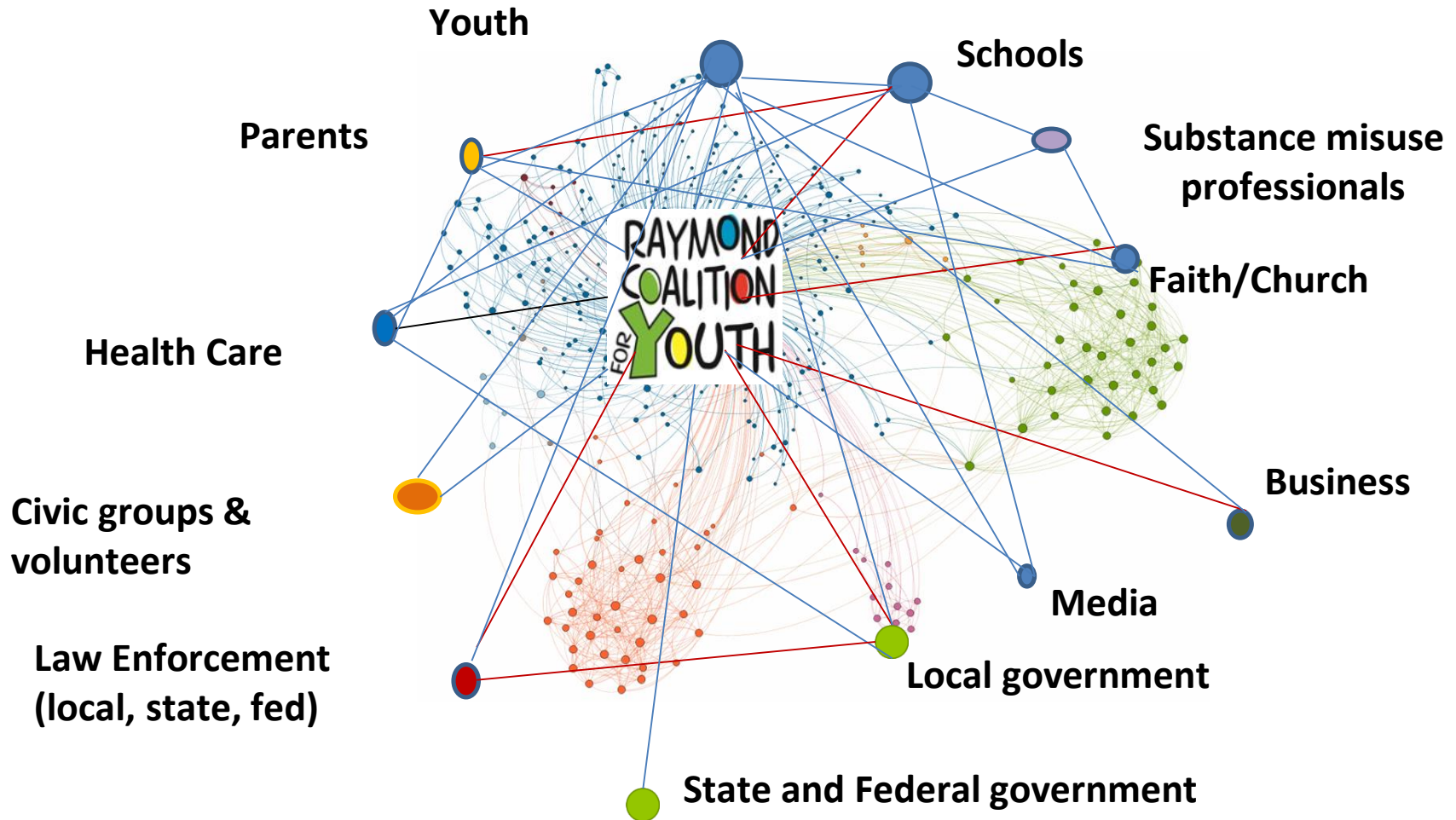

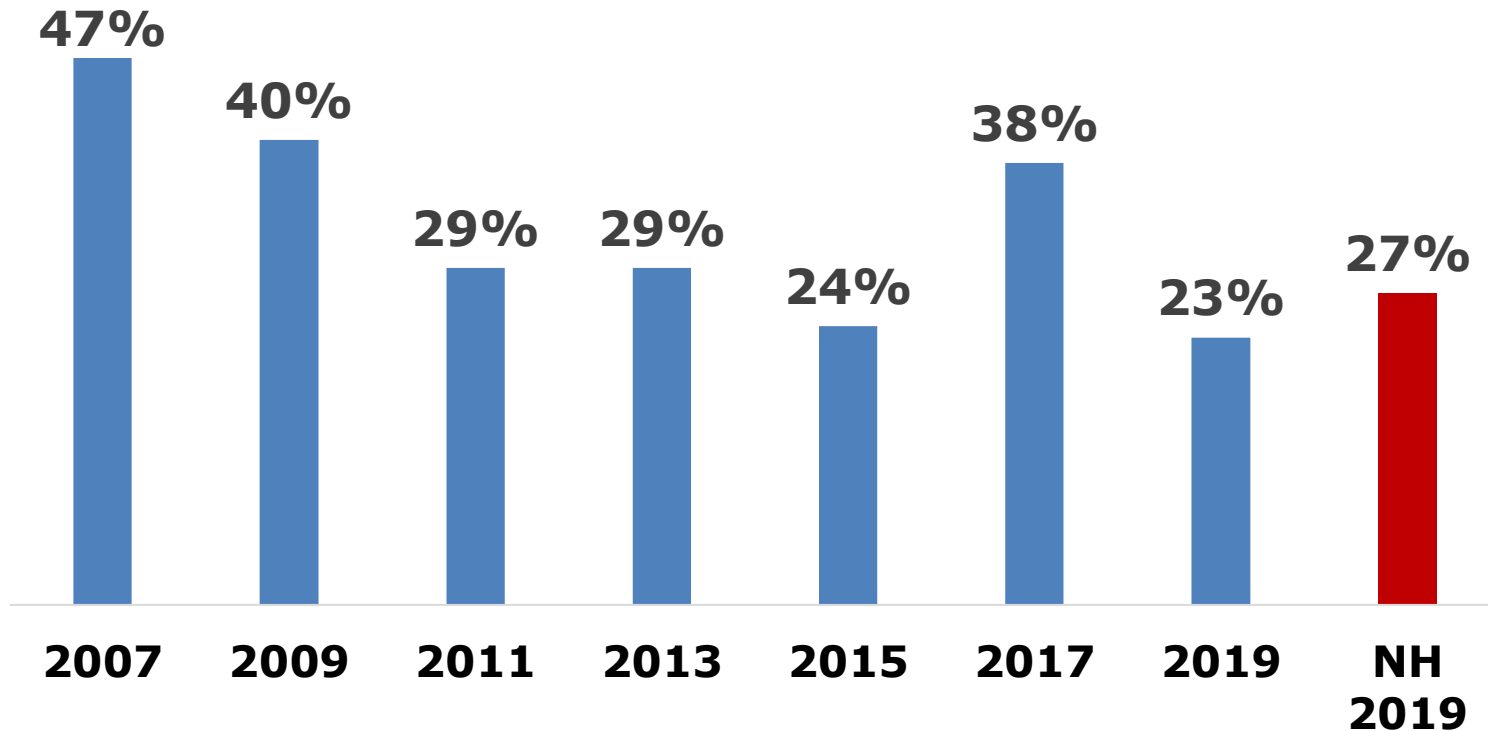

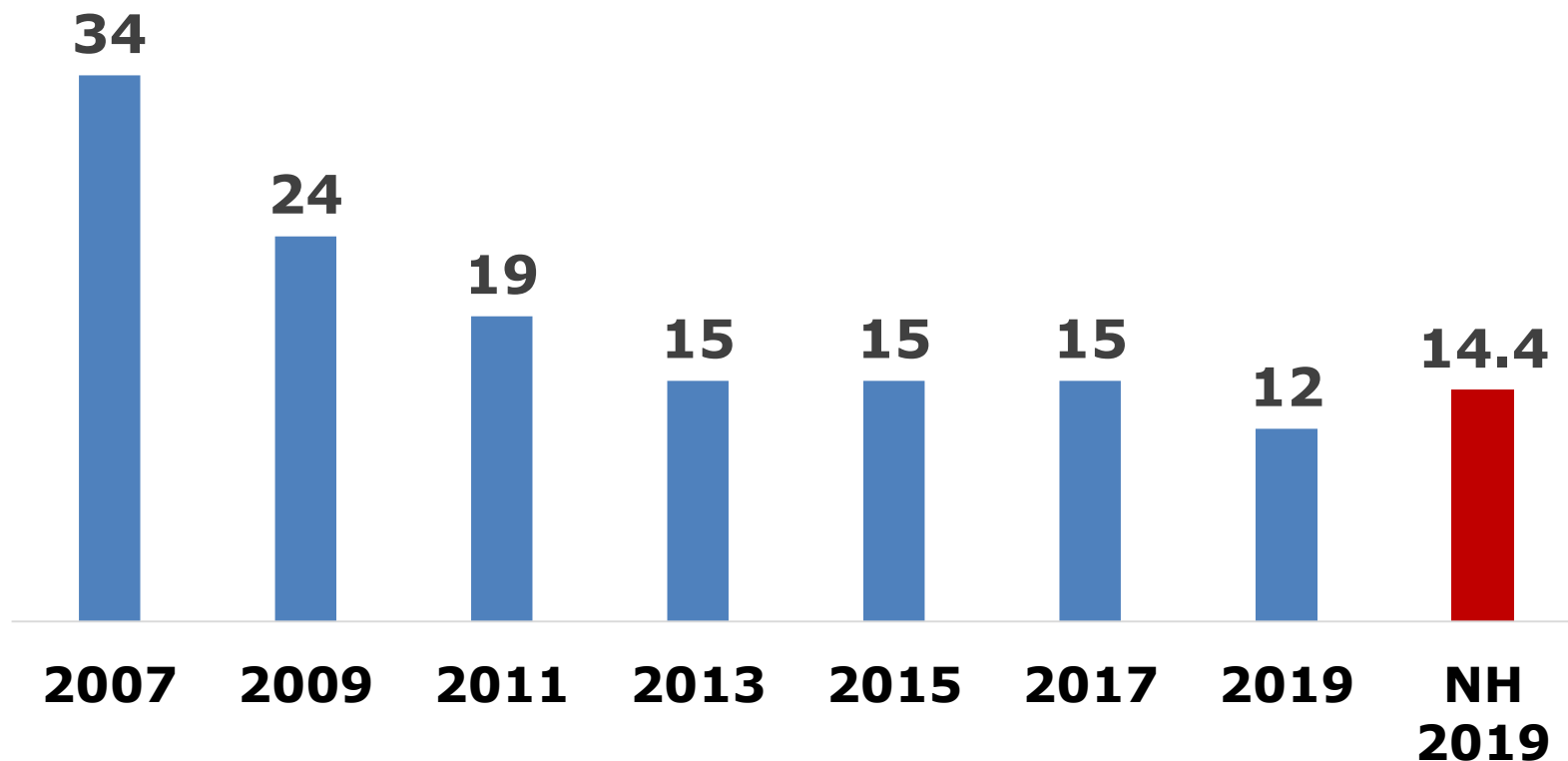
Past 30 day use – Alcohol

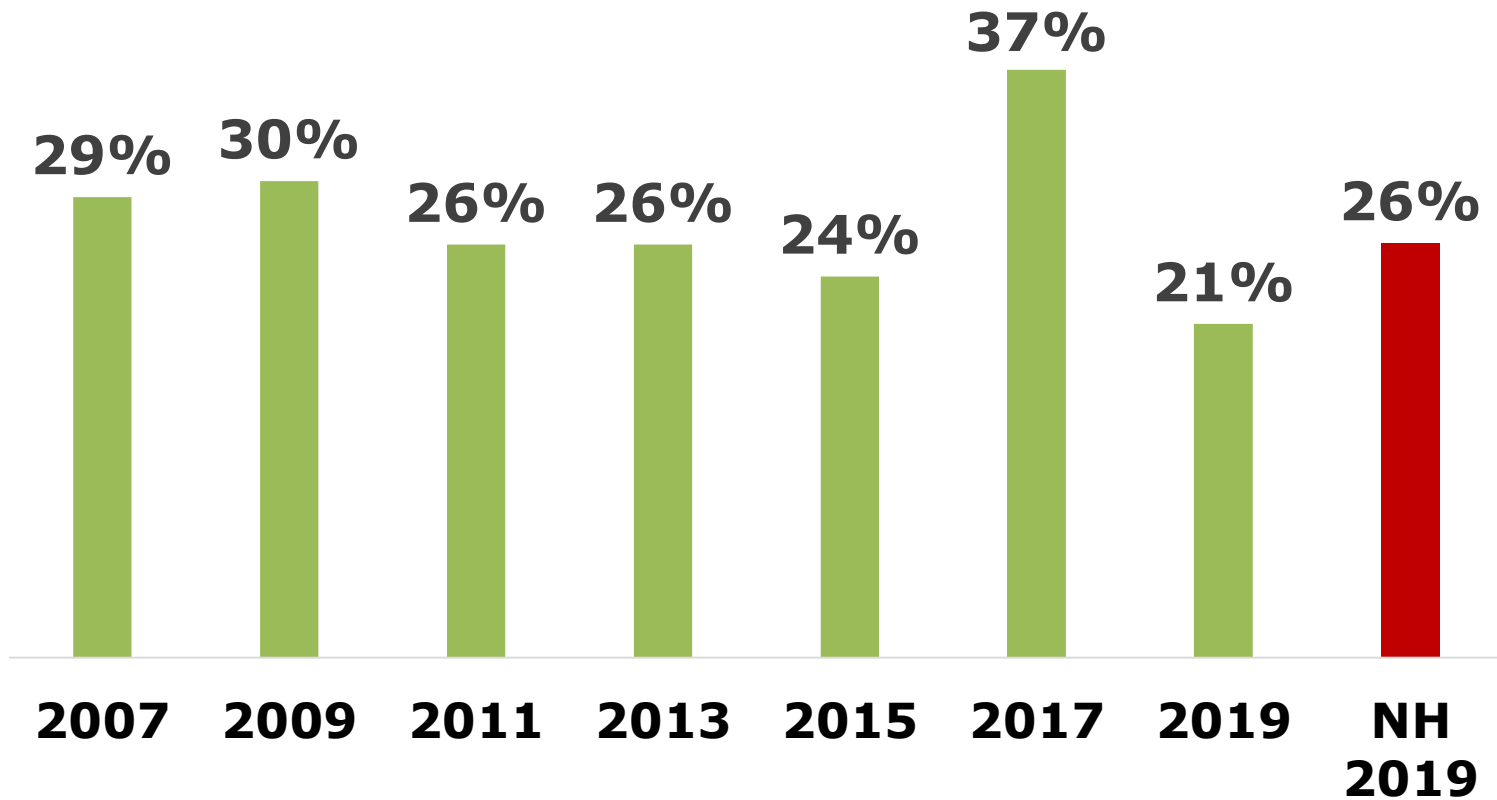
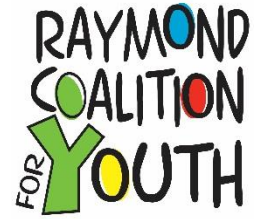


Binge Drinking, 5 + drinks in one sitting

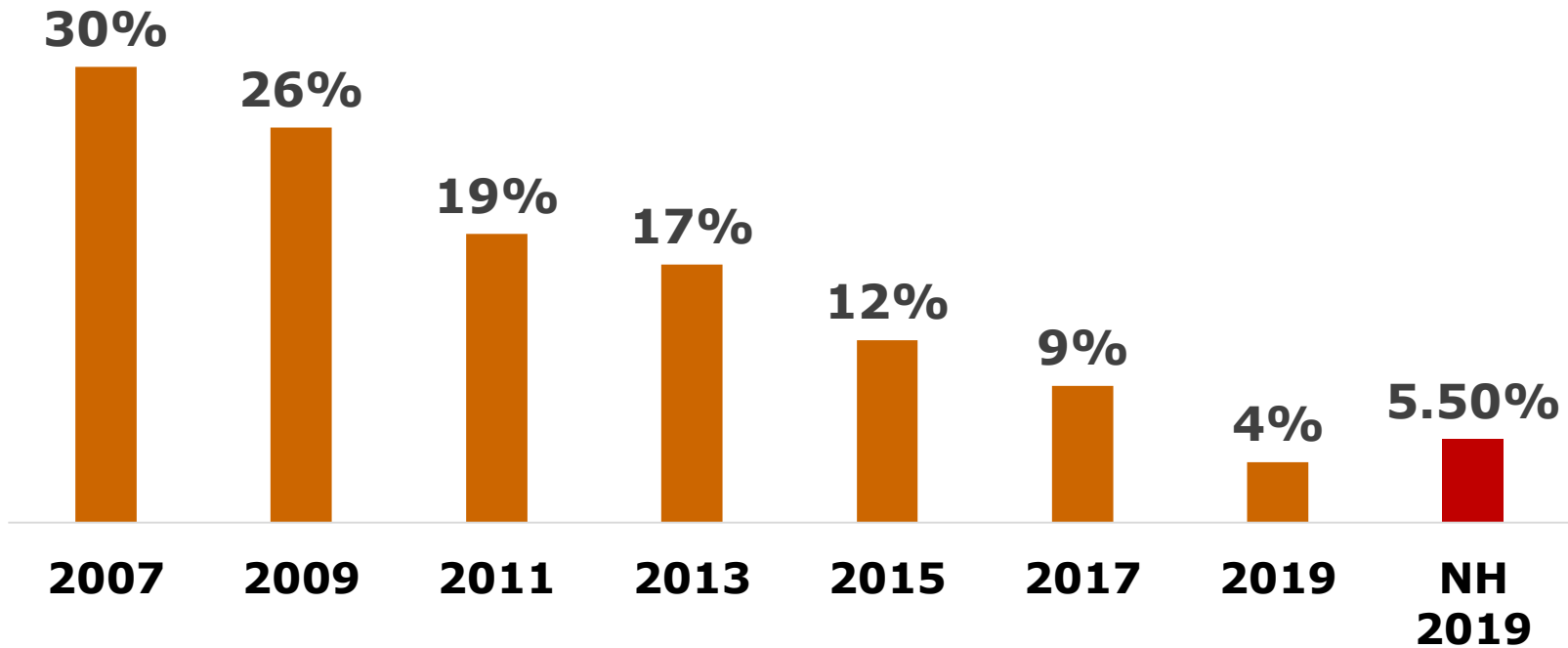


Past 30 day – Marijuana use Raymond High – State of NH

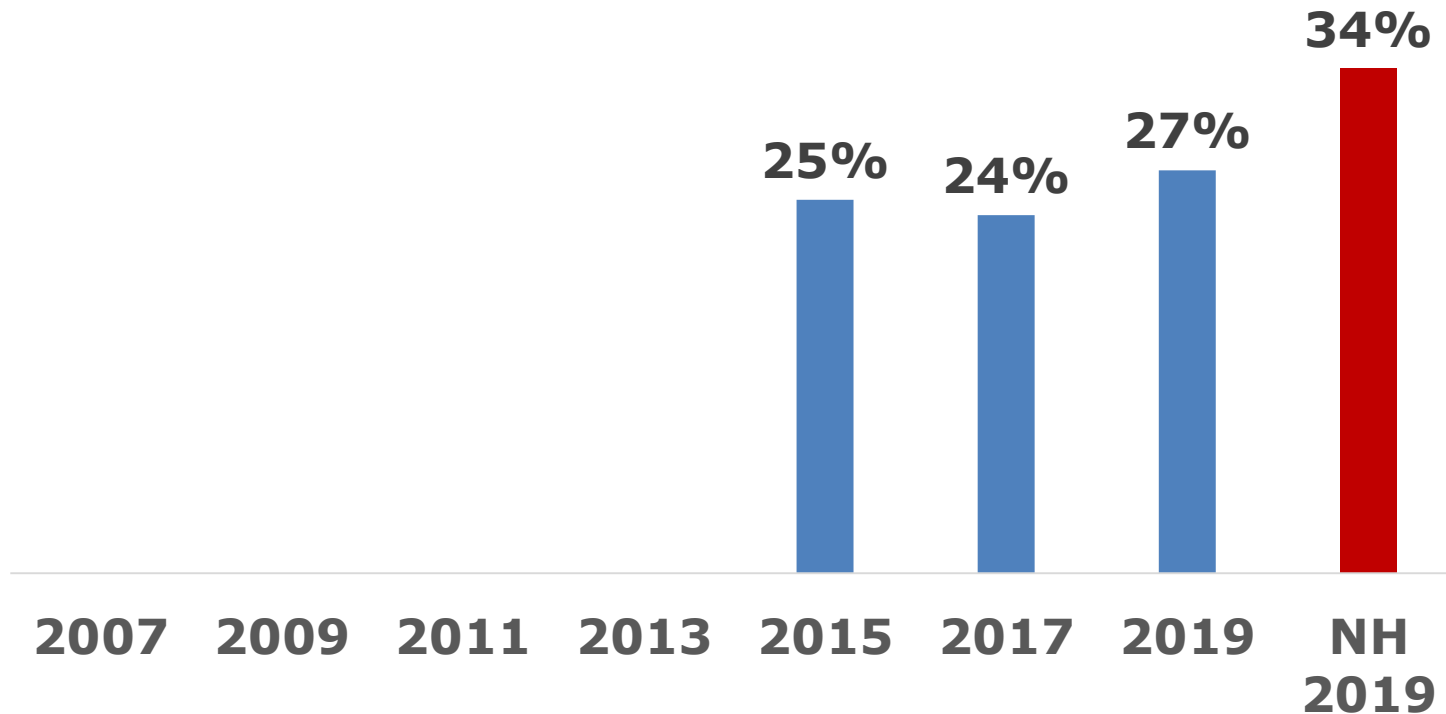
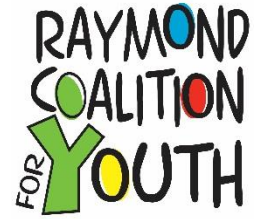


Past 30 day - Cigarette and Raymond High – State of NH

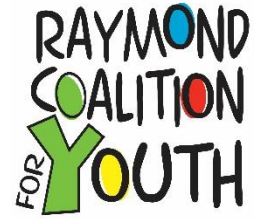

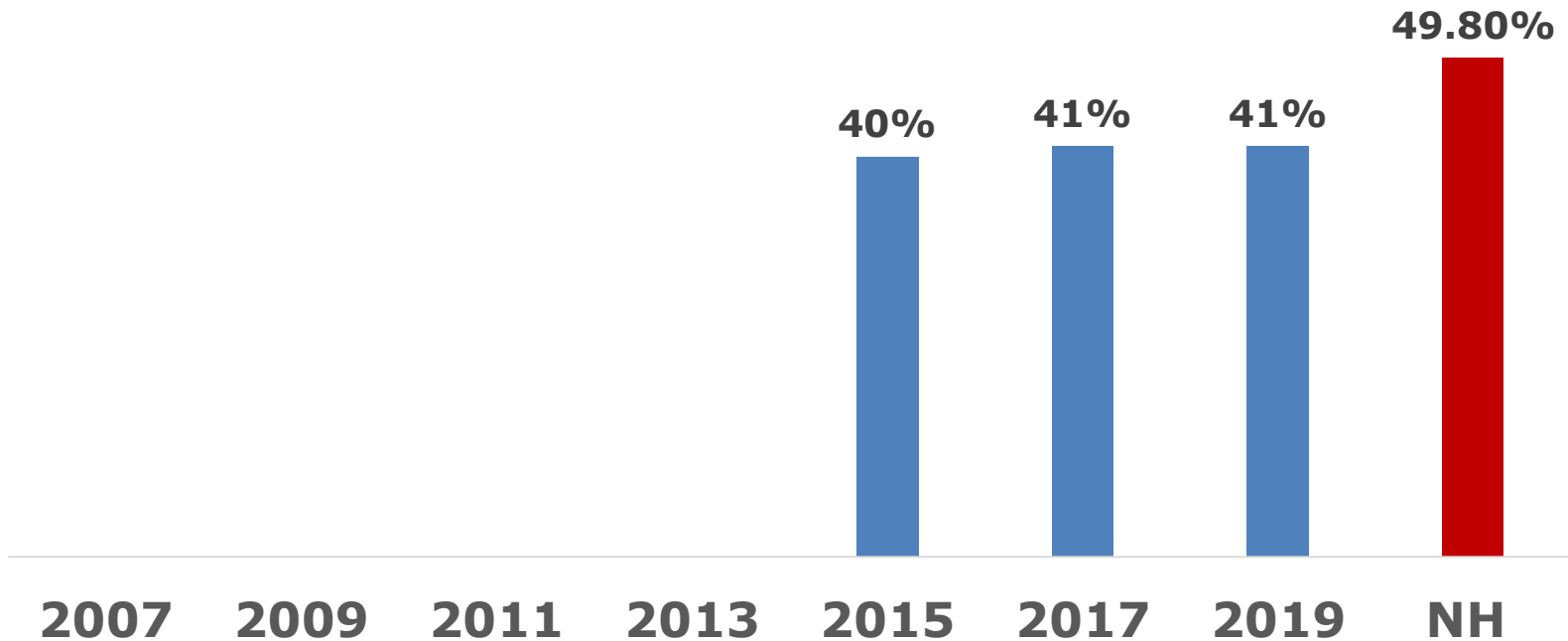
Past 30 day - Electronic Vapor Use Raymond High – State of NH



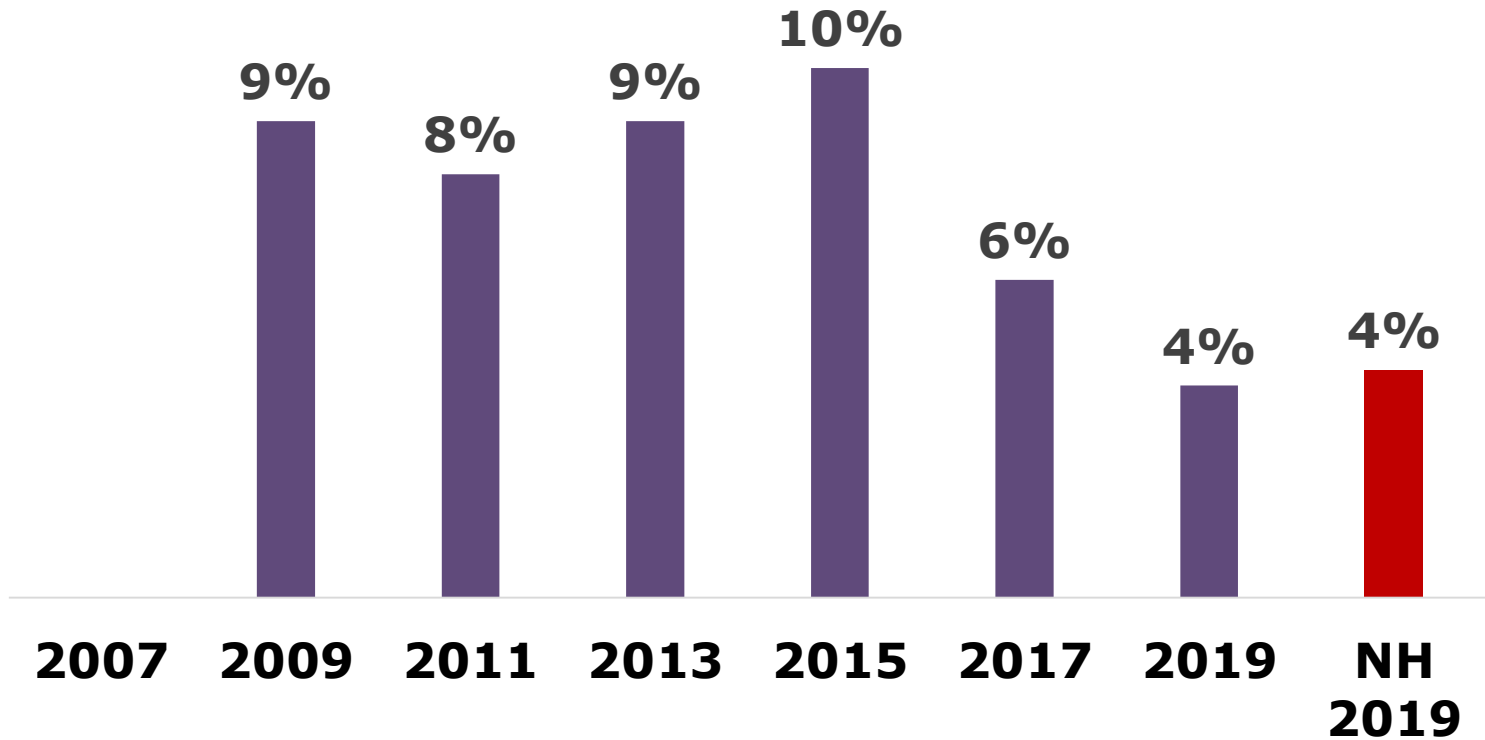
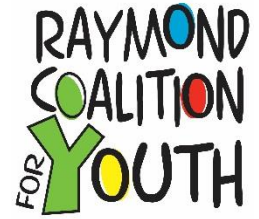
Students who have ever USED Electronic Vape



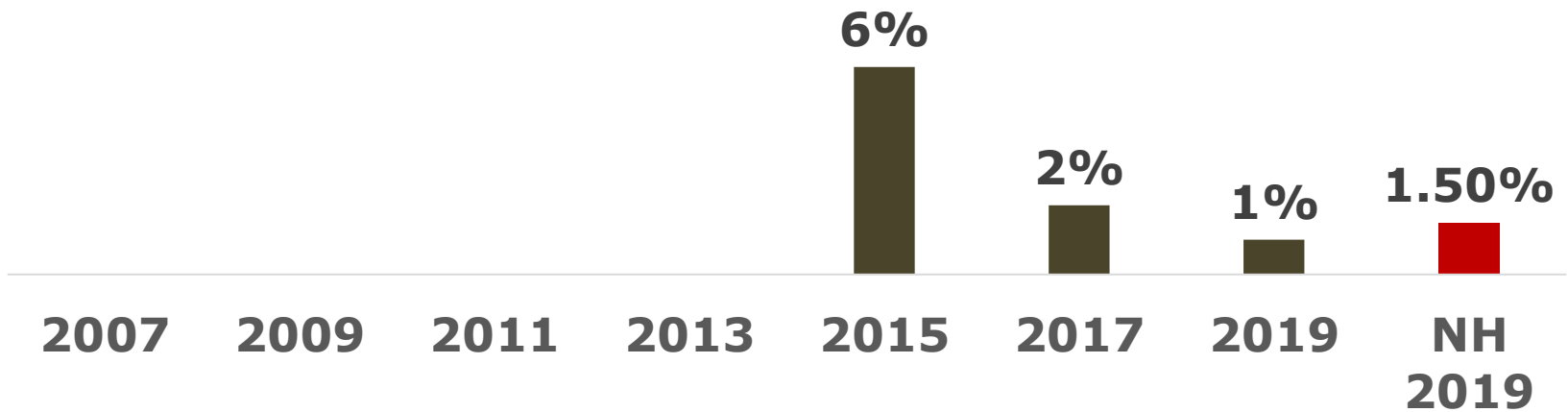

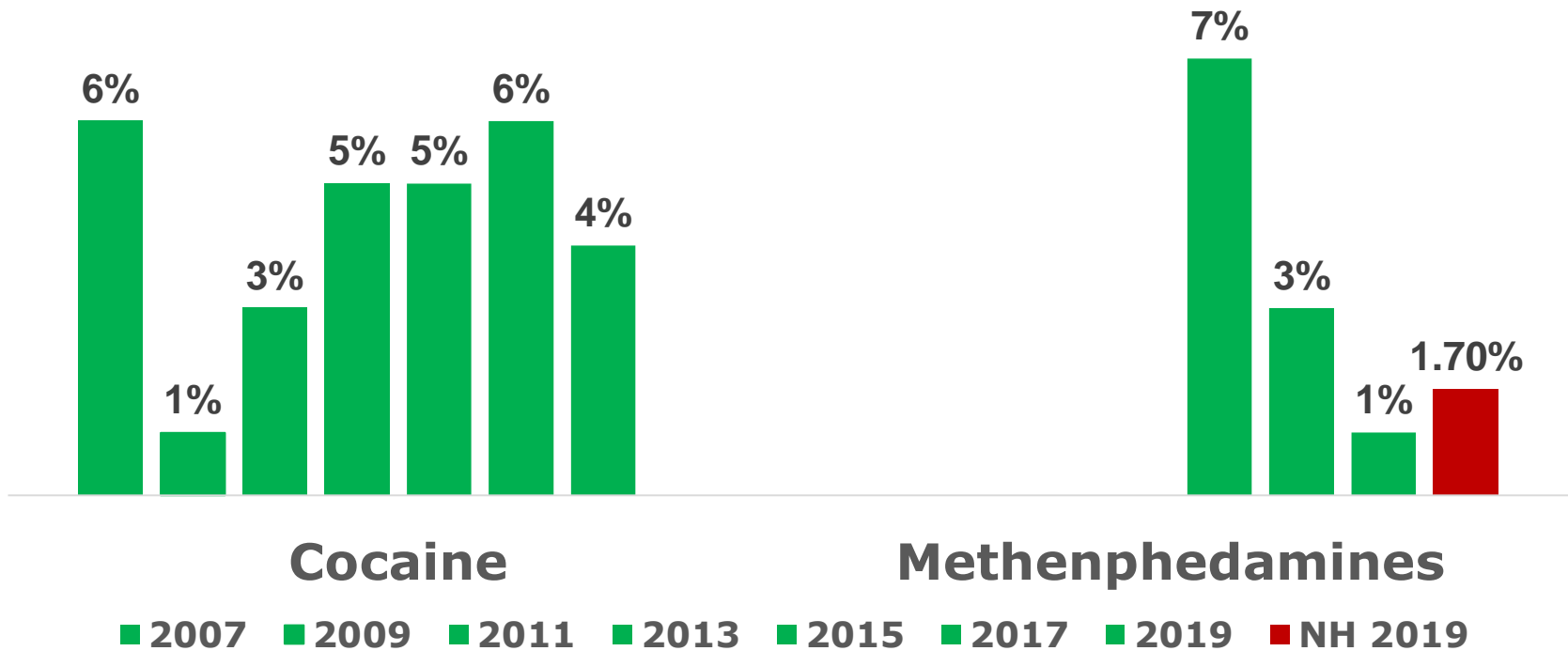
Past 30 day - Prescription Drug Misuse Raymond High – State of NH



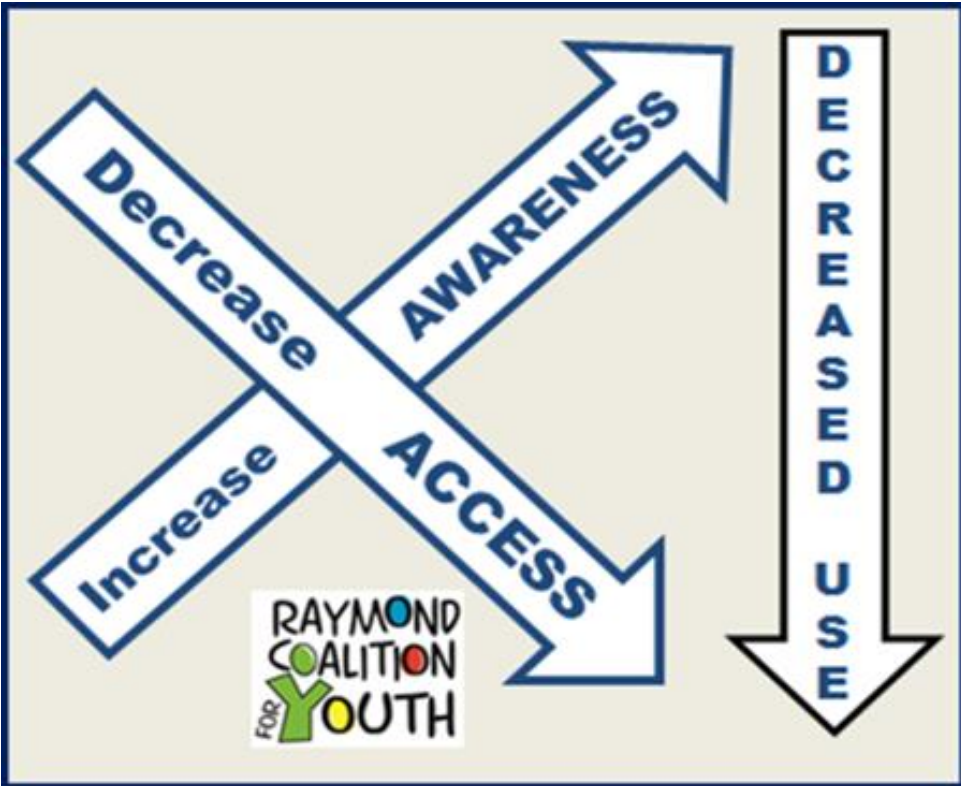
Past 30 day - Heroin/Opioid Raymond High – State of NH

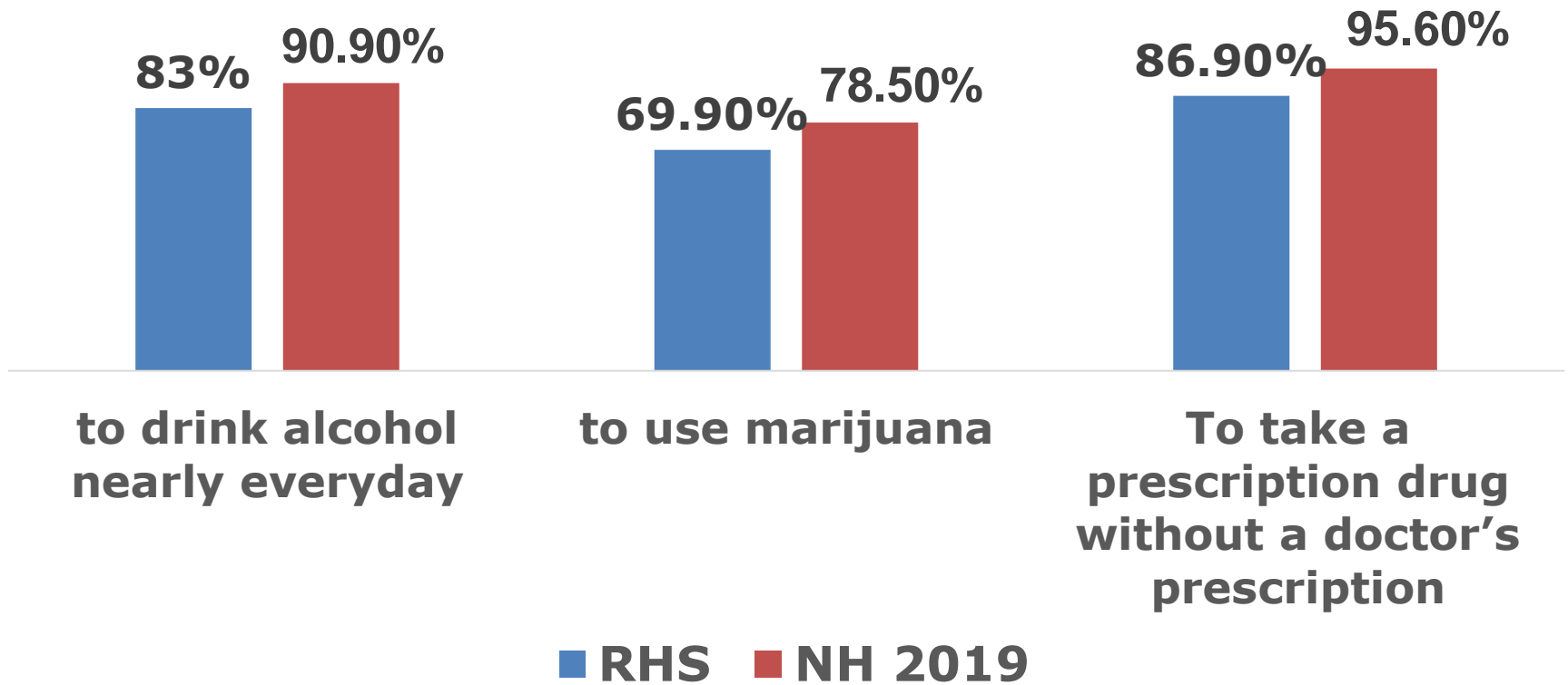
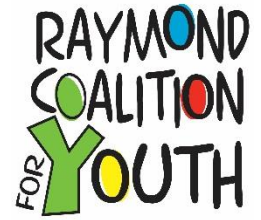

Of students had at least one parent who talked with them about the dangers of tobacco, alcohol, or drug use during the past 12 months.

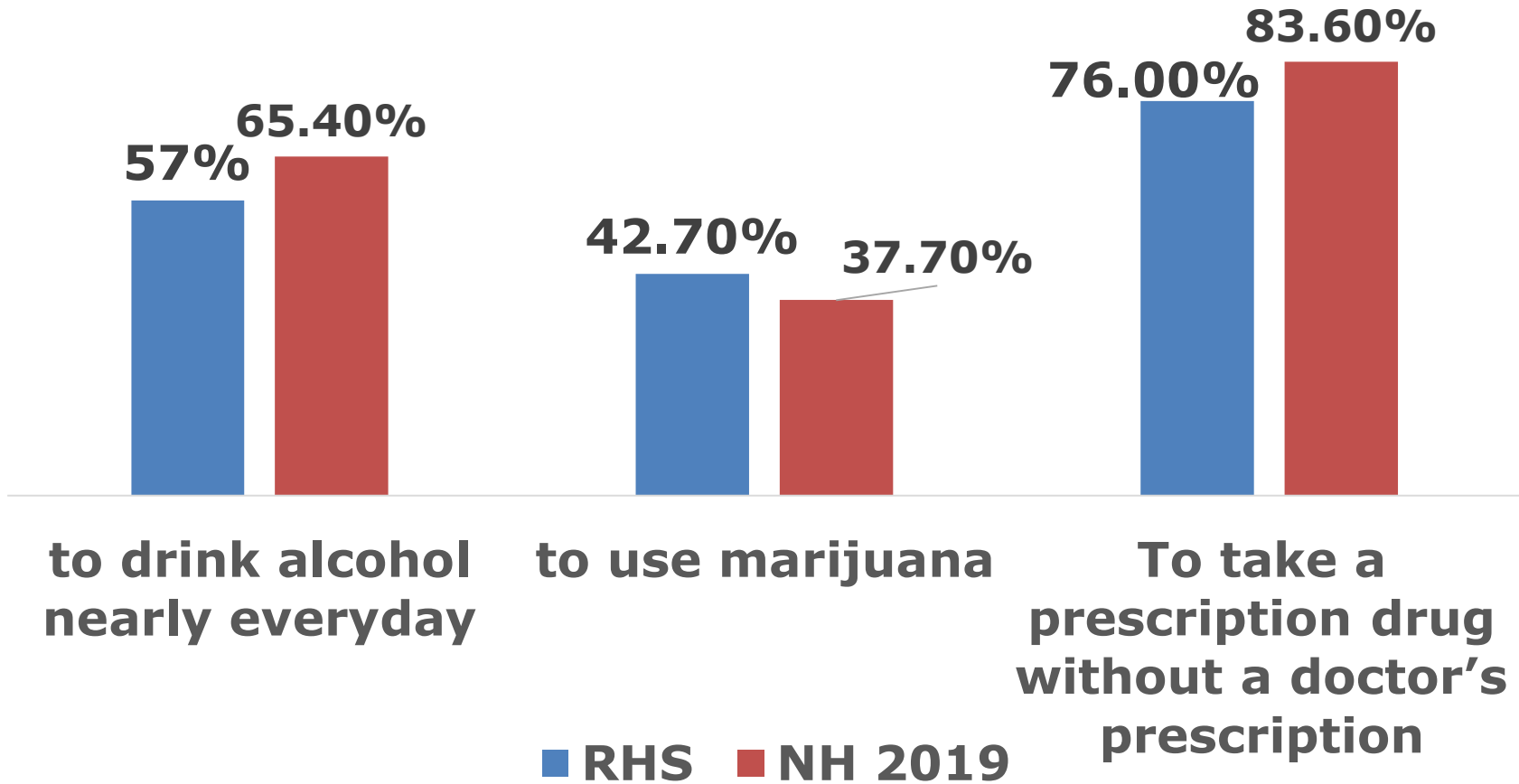
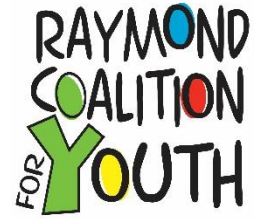

Of students agree or strongly agree that parents or other adults in the family have clear rules and consequences for their behavior.

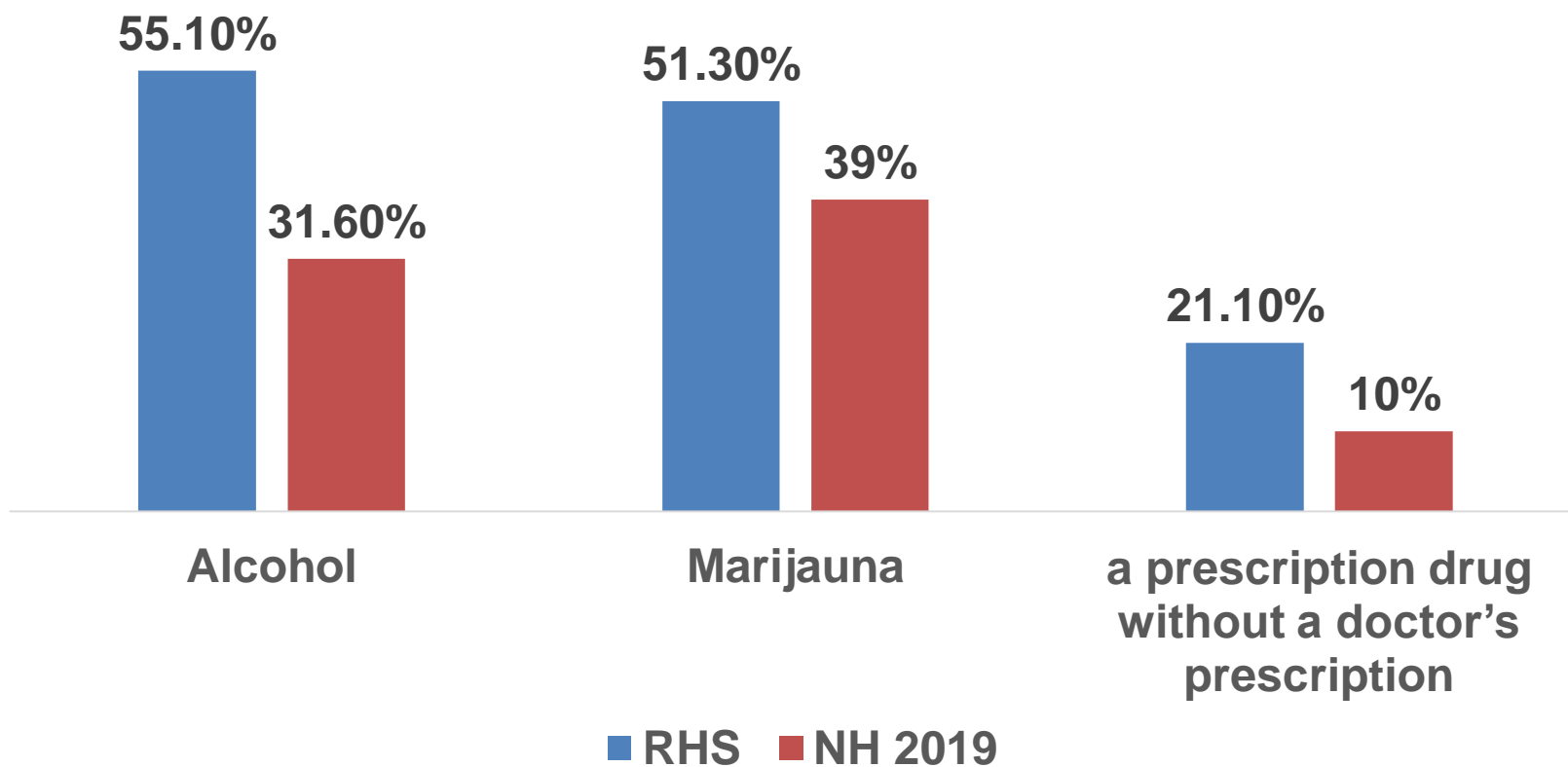

Students whose **FRIENDS** feel it is wrong or very wrong for them

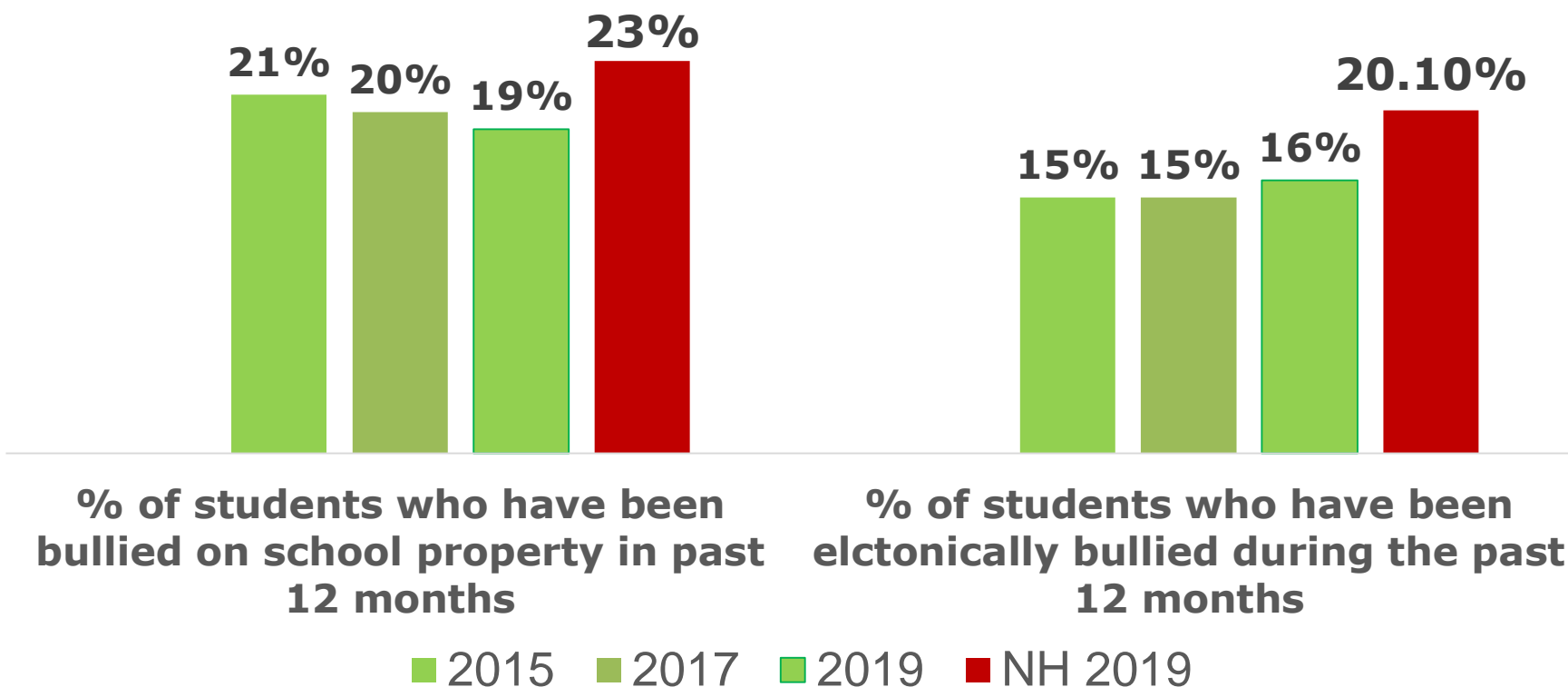

Suicide and Self Injury	2013	2015	2017	2019	NH 2019
Students who seriously considered suicide in the past 12 months	16%	17%	15%	18%	18.40%
Students who have felt so sad or hopeless everyday for two weeks or more in a row, that they stopped doing their usual activities.	23%	30%	31%	31%	33.60%
Students who actually attempted suicide in the past 12 months	7%	9%	6%	8%	7%
Students who purposely injured themselves in the past 12 months(w/o wanting to die)	21%	18%	14%	17%	19.80%
