

2019 Youth Risk Behavior Survey Results with comparison to NH YRBS


The Raymond Coalition For Youth empowers the community to promote positive youth development and reduce youth substance use, and suicide risk.








Past 30 day use – Alcohol Raymond HS - State of NH






Binge Drinking, 5 + drinks in one sitting RHS – State of NH




Past 30 day – Marijuana use Raymond High – State of NH






Past 30 day - Cigarette and Raymond High – State of NH









Students who have ever USED Electronic Vape Raymond High – State of NH


Past 30 day -Prescription Drug Misuse Raymond High – State of NH


Past 30 day -Heroin/Opioid Raymond High – State of NH




Past 30 day use/current use Raymond – State of NH










Students who think it would be easy or very easy to get
