

2020 School Reopening Proposed Schedule Adjustments

Raymond School District - August 19th

Overview

- In light of the pandemic and our substantially modified school opening, the administrative team asks the Board to consider adjustments to our school schedules that are either necessary for health and safety reasons, or that maximize the on-site time students have with their teachers (or both).
- Proposed schedule adjustments will be highlighted and discussed for each of our three schools and the preschool program.

Raymond School District Preschool Program

Early Childhood Programming

As an early childhood program, the Raymond School District Preschool maintains at least a 50/50 ratio of students with educational disabilities to students without disabilities. This provides a high quality, enriching learning environment for all students, and it is an inclusive educational setting for students with educational disabilities.

Traditional Program Offering

All children attend 4 days per week and days of attendance are Monday through Thursday in a morning or an afternoon session. Children who are identified with an educational disability and who require special education supports and services are placed according to the support needs identified in their IEP.

- Morning Session - 9:00 AM to 11:30 AM
- Afternoon Session - 12:30 PM to 3:00 PM

Lamprey River Elementary School Proposed Schedule Adjustments

LRES DAILY SCHEDULE

- Students begin arriving at 8:30am, dismissal will begin around 3:00pm
- Morning Meeting in all classes near the start of the day
- Classrooms at all grade levels are self-contained and students will be instructed in all content areas throughout the day (Literacy, Math, & Science/Social Studies)
- Students will participate in a UA class each day
- Lunch periods will begin at 10:45am and run until 1:15am
- Students will participate in recess each day

Additions/ Modifications made to the Daily Schedule

- UA schedule will change to include 9 week sessions where each UA is paired with a grade level instead of each classroom seeing all UA classes in a A-E rotating schedule
- Grade level lunches : will be using more than just the cafe for lunch periods, PE will be more often in classrooms than usual, dependent on weather
- Interventions will take place both remotely and in-person (Title I Teachers, Reading Specialists, Math Specialists)

Iber Holmes Gove Middle School Proposed Schedule Adjustments

The approved MS schedule is an alternating block schedule.

If maintained, students would have each class one time per week in our hybrid reopening.

Draft MS Schedule:

- 6 period day, 50-55 minute classes
- Students would have each of their class each day they are in person.
- UA's would be scheduled for four week blocks, 8 lessons.

Draft MS Schedule:

- Interventions on days when students are not on-site at school
 - Spec Ed, Title I, Reading and Math support live, but remote

Raymond High School Proposed Schedule Adjustments

The approved 20 - 21 RHS schedule is an alternating 'block schedule.'

If maintained in a hybrid environment, students would have each class one time per week.

- We are proposing to adopt a 4x4 modified block schedule.
 - Block 1 - 4 would run through the 1st semester.
 - Blocks 5 - 7 would run the 2nd semester.
 - Block 2 would run duration of the school year.
