Pages 15-19	Health Services: The school nurses reviewed the Health Services section of the handbooks. Following are their proposed revisions of note. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Remove COVID testing. As of October, testing will not be done in the schools.</li><li>● “Individual Health Counseling” changed to “Individual Health Care Planning” to align with wording in IHP’s (Individualized Health Plans).</li><li>● Remove vaping/tobacco cessation counseling.</li><li>● “Health education in collaboration with interdisciplinary school team” added because “The school nurse assists students, families, school staff and the community to achieve optimal levels of wellness through appropriately designed and delivered health education.”</li><li>● Notarization is no longer needed for religious exemption.</li><li>● Guidelines regarding illnesses added to “Communicable Diseases”</li><li>● Returning to School After an Injury or Hospitalization - the nursing team felt it was important to add this information, as it’s been a concern at all three schools.</li><li>● Page 20, additional revisions as per the 5.17 Board mtg and review with nurses: The Board asked to more clearly require the same symptom-free requirements for COVID-19 as for other illnesses (last bullet), and during review the nurses asked to revise the wording for antibiotics. Both new additions are noted in green.</li></ul>
Pages 20	Behavioral Health Wellness - Updated as per Director of Behavioral Health, less verbiage than the other schools as information is shared throughout the handbook for supports available for students of this age.
Pages 21-24	Student Support Services - Updated as per Executive Director of Student Support Services
