Monday - Students are to check grades with their RAM teacher. The student will schedule time with individual teachers using the following criteria first, second, and third:

1. Summative assessment - missing or retake
2. Formative assessment - missing or retake
3. Homework - missing or retake

Students who are passing and have no missing assignments, should remain in their RAM Tuesday - Thursday to do any additional work and may partake in in-class enrichment activities. On Fridays, students who are passing with no owed assignments are permitted to sign up for and attend a large scale enrichment activity (TBD). Any student not passing a class or with owed assignments will not be permitted to sign up for the large enrichment, but will have an additional help session.

Utilizing Adaptive Scheduler, a teacher with different preps has the option to focus on one course during a RAM day. Teachers should schedule the RAM week based on summative and formative work given the previous week. All teachers must offer at least 3 days (potentially four) of relearning/reassessment time.

Students will be able to schedule time out of their RAM with individual teachers beginning Tuesday, September 12, 2023.
