NH House Bill 1612 Compliance

- Data Management and Governance Plan (approved last year)
- ▶ Need to update several policies that reference technology for staff and students
- We are an active member with the (NHCTO) and (CosN) New Hampshire Chief Technology Officer Consortium which is the NH affiliate to CosN Consortium for School Networking
- ▶ We are part of (NHSPA) New Hampshire Student Privacy Alliance (An organization to keep our 3rd party vendors compliant with state and federal regulations.)
- These are the organizations that we maintain membership with to stay complaint with HB1612
- Most recent example is the newly awarded Project Aware, they need a data sharing agreement, and we are working with the NHSPA to obtain a DPA.

Cyber Threat Assessment / Risk Analyses

▶ We have contracted with two independent consultants to evaluate the digital footprint of the Raymond School District. Both companies will be looking at specific aspects of our environment. Amplified IT will be looking at our Google admin console and domain. (RTM) Removing the Mystery will be our onsite assessment.
