Steve Woodward will be talking with the Board about enrichment opportunities for students next year. Below is some information provided by Mr. Woodward. We expect to have more information to add before Wednesday's meeting.

Updated Information:

The Universal Block will be scheduled as two mini blocks of 41 minutes on the day it meets.

Students will be scheduled during this time via the Enriching Students software. Scheduling will occur during RAP and the Universal Block on Mondays. RAP Teachers, who have a struggling student in a class, can also schedule a student to them during this block of time.

The following options will be available to students during the Universal Block -

- 1.) Teacher will assign students to teachers for the purpose of re-teaching and relearning materials.
- 2.) This time may be used to make up assignments with specific teachers
- 3.) Each department will offer an enrichment activity each week and this will be available to students who do not require re-teaching and relearning.
- 4.) Library computers will be available to students who do not require specific help but need access to a computer for work completion.
- 5.) 2 content (Math & English) specific computer labs available to students.May add a third content area as well.
- 6.) Once a week, during this time, freshmen will receive mini lessons on topics such as study habits, life skills, media usage and college and career counseling. We may expand this to include mini-lessons for upperclassmen as well.
- 7.) Students will have the option of working on Extended Learning Opportunities during this time.
- 8.) Students taking VLACS or PLATO courses can work on them while maintaining a regular academic schedule.

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The following options will be available to students during the Universal Block -

- 1.) Teacher will assign students to teachers for the purpose of re-teaching and relearning materials.
- 2.) This time may be used to make up assignments with specific teachers
- 3.) Each department will offer an enrichment activity each week and this will be available to students who do not require re-teaching and relearning.
- 4.) Computer labs will be staffed for the purpose of research and work completion.
- 5.) Once a week during this time freshmen will receive mini lessons on topics such as study habits, life skills, media usage and college and career counseling.
