One of our Board members requested that this item be put on the agenda to consider the possibility of purchasing some Chromebooks with surplus funds.

To aid in discussion: one Chromebook cart holds 18 Chromebooks. The cart itself is budgeted at \$1,000 and Chromebooks at \$260 (\$4,680 for all 18), for a total of \$5,680 budgeted for a cart at each school this coming school year.

The Chromebooks we purchased in December were at a cost of about \$232 with all the add-ons and shipping.
