<u>Call to Order</u>: The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM. Capital Improvements Plan Work Session:

The Board reviewed the proposed CIP Plan as found in the meeting agenda with Marjorie Whitmore.

While the LRES Building Committee is working on a plan for the building, the Board would like to move the LRES projects out for a few years- until 2023-2024.

In regards to spending \$103,000 for the RHS wall, the consensus of the Board was to leave it in 2021-2022.

In regards to the \$23,243 for the upgraded controls needed for the water lines, the consensus of the Board was to leave it in 2021-2022.

In regards to the \$22,050 for the RHS Bathroom flooring, the consensus of the Board was to leave it in 2021-2022.

Marjorie Whitmore will find out from Todd Ledoux when the last time a bathroom was done. In regards to the RHS Control Upgrades as well as RHS Boiler Upgrades, those will be put off for one more year.

In regards to the Food Service Equipment, the consensus of the Board was to leave those in 2021-2022.

In regards to the technology savings for future projects, the Board supports the decision to space out the savings as the district presented.

For the 2022-2021 year, if the goal is for a total of \$375,000 for the warrant article, these changes would total \$339,295 (\$151,992 to Technology, \$39,010 to Food Service and \$141,293 to Facilities). The remainder (\$35,705) would go into maintenance and facilities for a total of \$183,998 to Facilities.

The Board confirmed that they would like to move everything from LRES to 2023-2024.
