This agenda item has been added to allow the School Board to review the current meal prices and determine if prices will remain the same for the upcoming school year. The current meal prices are listed below.

Current student meal prices:

RHS \$1.90 Breakfast, \$3.20 Lunch

IHGMS \$1.65 Breakfast, \$2.95 Lunch

LRES \$1.65 Breakfast, \$2.80 Lunch

Given the uncertainty of the economy at this time, we do not recommend price increases for lunches for the 2020-21 school year. However, we do believe that increases of ten cents for breakfasts at all schools should be considered. As always, we defer to the judgement of the Board.

7:25 PM F. Remote Learning Schedule _____ Discussion

I'd like to direct your attention to [a collaborative letter](#) from the New Hampshire School Boards Association, the New Hampshire School Administrators Association, the New Hampshire Association of Special Education Administrators, the New Hampshire Association of School Principals, the National Education Association of New Hampshire and the New Hampshire Career and Technical Education professional association. The letter contains agreed upon recommendations and guidelines for remote learning. One of the recommendations is for schools to have one flexible day per week of instruction.

The administration gathered input from employees, and has put out a parent survey to obtain input. Based on all of this information, I and the administration believe that it will be in the best interests of students if we institute one day per week for students to connect, enrich and catch up. The elementary school has been doing a 'no screen day' since we started and it's going well. The other two schools would be better served by having a day when students can work independently on extended activities, connect with teachers and counselors, or catch up with work. We are offering this recommendation for your consideration.

NHSBA Revision Notes: "Minor changes made to include reference to new EH-R (Administrative Procedures for Public Access to District Records) and slight changes to more accurately reflect statutory requirements. Some paragraphs of the former version were rearranged for better flow.

[BEDG-R Access to Minutes and Public Records](#) (Withdraw Policy)

NHSBA Revision Notes: "The former BEDH-R [sic] and the former version of sample policy EH covered the exact same subject matter, though in different formations. Because of the redundancies, NHSBA determined to merge the two. However, because of the frequent amendments to 91-A over the past 15 years, and the general lag in time to get policies approved, as compared to the greater flexibility of administrative procedures, NHSBA has placed the procedural elements of former EH and BEDG-R into new procedural document EH-R."

As noted above, the subject matter of EH and BEDG-R have been merged and the procedural elements have been re-codified into EH-R, below.

NHSBA Revision Notes: "... the subject matter of this new procedures document is derived from a merger of former BEDG-R (now withdrawn) and earlier sample policy EH (now revised). This sample (former BEDG-R), also includes revisions to reflect legislative changes to RSA 91-A:4, IV by 2019 N.H. Laws Ch. 163 (HB 286) and Ch. 107 (HB 396), the most significant of which requires a written statement identifying the specific exemption under 91-A:5 or otherwise that applies when a record is withheld from disclosure (or redacted)."

7:50 PM F. Authorization for Supt to Enter into Contracts with the State __ _ Action

We've been notified that the Board must vote to authorize the Superintendent to sign an updated grant that is awarded through the Department of Health and Human Services. This is the SAP (Student Assistance Program) grant - that provides drug and alcohol abuse prevention, awareness and services to students at RHS and IHGMS.
