*Celeste Clark will be at the meeting to assist with discussion about approval for the Youth Risk Behavior Survey at the middle school level. Our Policy states that Board approval for the Youth Risk Behavior Policy (YRBS) is not required, but I sought legal clarification regarding the middle school level survey. Our attorney has advised that, because the Department of Health and Human Services defines the YRBS as a national survey, conducted by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) every two years among representative samples of **9th through 12th grade** students. Because of this, the correct interpretation of our Policy is to have Board approval and, if approved, opt-in permission for middle school students to participate.*
