		Due to the COVID-19 crisis and Remote Learning, some adjustments to the 2019-2020 calendar are worthy of consideration. To be specific:
		The last day of school for students The parent-teacher conference schedule
		The New Hampshire Department of Education has determined that hours of instruction

The New Hampshire Department of Education has determined that hours of instruction during remote learning days will be counted as the same as the number of hours of instruction that takes place during regular (traditional on-site) school days.

The recommendation of the superintendent is to work through the previously scheduled spring break, and have June 5, 2020 as the last day for students. Additionally, the superintendent recommends that the last day for preschool and kindergarten students be May 29th. Finally, the superintendent recommends that for this year only (given a Memorandum of Agreement for the REA) the District allows teachers to communicate with parents at any time that is mutually agreeable and not during a specifically scheduled parent-teacher conference time frame.

Alternatively, the Board can consider keeping the spring break as scheduled and having June 12, 2020 as the last day for students.

The District calendar schedule is a Board decision and the administration open to any other scenario that the Board determines is appropriate.
