District Community Leadership Team (DCLT) - Board representation on this committee is important and appreciated. The administration would like to have one Board member appointed, with another designated as an alternate if the Board is amenable.

Conservation Commission Representative - in the past, when the outdoor walking trail by LRES was being created, a Board member was appointed to serve on the Conservation Commission to participate in discussion relevant to the District. At this time there is no need to have a Board member represent the District on the Conservation Commission. If a salient issue arises in the future, which necessitates the involvement of a Board representative, the matter can be reconsidered.

Competency Based Education Committee - the work of the committee as it existed in the past centered around the direction of the District in relation to Competency Based Education (CBE). With CBE well underway in our District, the work at hand has shifted. Committee work with educators at all levels will continue, but a Board representative is not needed to serve in this capacity.

Raymond Area Rotary Club - the Board can determine if a representative to the rotary club should be appointed, and/or if an alternate should also be appointed. Please note that one must be invited to join. That being said, an invitation for a school board representative should be easy to obtain. At this time meetings are held via Zoom on Wednesdays at 7:30 AM.

REA/District Contract Negotiations - due to the fact that the agreement between the Raymond Education Association and the Raymond School District did not pass, the collective bargaining agreement needs to be renegotiated.

RESS/District Contract Negotiations - the contract between the Raymond Education Support Staff union and the Raymond School District ends on June 30, 2022. Therefore, the collective bargaining agreement needs to be renegotiated during the next school year.

This agenda item is for discussion of potential options regarding conducting a Superintendent search.

Joseph Saulnier has been in contact with New Hampshire School Boards Association and is sharing the following correspondence from Barrett Christina: "Thanks for the email. At this point, trying to find an interim would be my suggestion, and then open a full search next school year. The interim pool is so-so right now. But I certainly have some candidates in my Rolodex that I can reach out to. I would also advise putting together an advertisement in the next week or so. I'd recommend posting it on SchoolSpring and EdjobsNH. SchoolSpring will cost about \$500-\$600 for a 30 day ad. Not sure about Edjobs, as that's hosted by the NH School Administrators Association. NHSBA also has an agreement with Maine and Massachusetts whereby they'll post ads for us.

"One question - would the board be willing to hire someone part-time - maybe 4 days a week? Most of the interims are retired superintendents who don't want to commit to full-time. Just something for the board to consider."

Additional from Joseph Saulnier: I was also able to speak with Barrett on Friday. During my conversation with Barrett he said even the interim position would have a limited pool of individuals who considered looking at the position depending on if we wanted a part or full time interim. Whatever way we decide NHSBA will be there to help us through the process and will have his Rolodex ready.
