The proposed policy represents the NHSBA model policy in its entirety. NHSBA has updated this policy to "include definitions and prohibitions relative to E-cigarettes and liquid nicotine, as well as reorganized for improved readability."

NHSBA's most recent changes to the policy have been "title and paragraph order to better distinguish reassignment requests based upon 'manifest educational hardship' under RSA 193:3, I (see policy JEC), from requests based upon 'best interests' under RSA 193:3, III."

The proposed policy is adapted from the NHSBA model policy. NHSBA's most recent updates have been "to reflect March 2018 changes in NH Dept of Ed. Rule 320 and to more closely track the language of Rule 320 and RSA 193:3,I." Title has been changed to better distinguish reassignment requests for manifest educational hardship from requests based on best interests.
