

Intent of the proposal-

In order to ensure consistency of behavior management for our tier III students struggling to self-regulate, a designated Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) from Constellations will oversee a program designed to support these students. The program will support students with and without disabilities that need support learning how to self-regulate their behaviors.

Students to be supported in this program will be selected through SIT meetings in consultation from administrators and counselors. The BCBA will track and analyze data for students who access this program.

The BCBA will develop behavior and intervention plans for students as needed in addition to educating students on behavior management and executive functioning skills. The BCBA will support special education and regular education teachers, as well as related service providers and support staff to ensure students have access to the general education curriculum as much as possible.

Currently, there are about 6 students that would benefit from this proposed program. The cost of this proposal is \$101,500 with an effective date of 1/4/23 through the end of the 22-23 school year, five days per week.

The district plans to actively recruit a Special Education teacher with a background in behavior management skills, to allow this program to continue into the 23-24 school year and bring some of our out-of-district students back in-district.
