School Board Subcommittees

- <u>Policy Committee</u>: As per Board policy, all new and revised policies go before the Policy Committee. Two Board Members to serve as representatives. Meetings scheduled as necessary.
- <u>Technology Committee</u>: One Board Member to serve. During the life of the technology plan, the committee will meet midway through the school year and again at the end of each school year to provide a "check in" to make sure that the district is on track. The committee will make any adjustments as needed.
- <u>Strategic Planning</u>: Annual review at the end of the school year. Date/time TBD.

School District Committees

- <u>Competency Based Education</u>: The District Competency Committee meets to support curriculum, instruction, and assessment practices that directly relate to competency and proficiency based learning. This committee works collaboratively as an advisory group to support all aspects of our shift to Competency Based Education. Meetings scheduled as necessary.
- <u>REA Sick Leave Bank</u>: One Board Member to serve. As per the REA Union Contract, employees may apply for additional sick time via the Sick Leave Bank. Meetings are held quarterly only if necessary.
- <u>Seacoast School of Technology</u>: One Board Member to serve as representative, one alternate. Meetings held once a month on a Monday at 4:30 PM, meetings currently held remotely (previously held at SST).
- <u>Transportation Committee</u>: One Board Member to serve as representative. Meetings and bus stop reviews as necessary based on parent requests and need.
- <u>Wellness Committee</u>: One (or more) Board Member to serve. As per policy JLCG, this Committee will "periodically assess the nutrition and physical activity throughout the District" and will "provide content area expertise and community input." Quarterly meetings throughout the school year, usually during the school day.

Town Committees

- <u>Budget Committee</u>: Typically one Board Member serves as the representative for the Budget Committee, and one serves as an Alternate Representative. Meetings have been held on Tuesday nights at 7:00 PM in the high school or remotely, as scheduled, with extra days during budget season as necessary.
- <u>Cable Committee</u>: One Board Member to serve as representative. Meetings are typically the 4th Tuesday of the month at 7:00 PM, meetings currently held remotely (previously held in RHS Media Center).
- <u>Capital Improvements Committee:</u> Two Board Members to serve as representatives. Meetings are scheduled prior to budget season as called by the Chair. The CIP Committee makes recommendations to the School Board regarding the School District Capital Improvements Plan.

 <u>Conservation Commission</u>: At the February 8, 2018 School Board meeting it was suggested that a School Board Member be appointed to work with the Conservation Commission regarding potential projects and improvements at LRES, the eco-center, and the Carroll Lake Beach area, and that a proposal then be brought back to the School Board. We may want to continue this type of cooperative effort with the Conservation Commission to address potential projects and improvements on any District properties. Meeting dates and frequency to be determined/ scheduled as necessary.

Community Committees

• <u>Raymond Coalition for Youth</u>: One Board Member to serve, second Thursday of the month, 9:00 AM (meetings currently held remotely, previously held at Lamprey Health Care, Raymond).

<u>Other</u>

- <u>Mentor for Student Representative</u>: One Board Member to serve. No set schedule.
- <u>Negotiations</u>: Two Board Members to serve as representatives. Meetings as scheduled.
- <u>NH School Boards Association</u>: One Board Member to serve as representative to the NHSBA Delegate Assembly in Concord as scheduled (one per year, typically a Saturday in January).
