From NHSBA: Policy JIC has been revised to include a provision describing the circumstances in which simple assaults will be reported to parents pursuant to RSA 193-D:4, I and NHDOE Administrative Rule 317.05. This provision is required if the District wishes to limit required reporting for assaults to those constituting first or second degree assaults.

And from an earlier update from NHSBA: This sample policy is revised: (a) to include mandated notice requirements; (b) with an update to the language regarding discipline of children with disabilities, and (c) to remove redundant provisions more appropriately included in sample policy JICD (which has also been substantially revised with the May 2018 policy update).
