7:50 PM G. Warrant Articles - Updates _____ Action

On November 20, 2019 the Board voted on the warrant articles for our March 2020 election. Since that time, our attorney has advised us against the Energy Efficiency Lease Repayment Fund warrant article. If the Board chooses to accumulate funds in our existing CRF for Equipment, Facilities Maintenance and Replacement to pay the lease in full ahead of schedule, then it could do that.

I very recently received some correspondence from the Town, indicating that wish to contribute a total of e\$55,997.11 during FY 21 (\$33,997.11 in the fall and \$22,000 in the spring), so I am asking the Board to consider that change to the article.

Other wording adjustments were also made to some of the warrant articles, including some title changes. The EEI Warrant was most challenging to craft due to a variety of factors. Included below you will see two updated draft versions of the warrant articles:
