For the purposes of this paragraph, one-time expenditures shall be appropriations not likely to recur in the succeeding budget, as determined by the governing body, unless the provisions of RSA 40:14-b are adopted, of the local political subdivision.

3100	Increase due to salaries and benefits
2200-2299	Increase due to salary, benefits & contracted services
1400-1499	Increase due to salaries
2310-2319	Decrease due to less contracted services
2600-2699	Decrease due to salaries, benefits, property & liability insurance
1100-1199	Decrease due to change in staff, which lowered salary & benefits
2400-2499	Increase due to salaries & benefits
1200-1299	Increase due to contracted services and out of district placements
