NAMING NEW FACILITIES

The naming of any School District property (land, buildings, or any portion thereof) is restricted to the legislative body only at an annual meeting. Subject names will be submitted to the legislative body by a committee appointed by the School District Moderator and consisting of 1 School Board member, 2 staff members, and 4 community members at large. They shall submit no more than 3 names for consideration to the legislative body. The name receiving the most votes shall be declared the chosen name.

The general procedures for naming a new school facility shall be:

1. The School Board shall appoint a committee composed of three citizens, and two members of the School Board.

2. Said committee to present a list of not less than three names, or more than five, to the School Board.

3. The Board will make a final decision.
