

Draft: Inclement Weather Remote Plans

Raymond Public Schools in the event of a weather emergency closure will switch to remote instruction. The district will make all efforts to provide students with the needed instructional support 24 hrs prior to the anticipated closure.

We will use the Inclement Weather Plan as a method to limit school days extending the school year late into the month of June.

Students schedules will be modified to support Inclement Weather Remote Plans.

Elementary Schedule

8:50am start time - this is when instruction begins with the morning meeting to start the day. Then teachers follow their normal academic schedule, holding a live google meet mini lesson at the beginning of each content area (literacy, math, science/ss, UA) Students complete work offline after the mini lesson presented. End time- 3:15pm

We would like to prepare a folder that goes home with the students along with the Chromebook and paper copies of activities aligned with the lessons that will be discussed live on the google meet.

Since our students don't bring Chromebooks back and forth each day, we would want our teachers to prepare 2 days worth of "emergency activities" to be sent home sometime in October for families to store, in case we cannot get Chromebooks in the hands of the students- last minute call for no school.

Middle School Schedule

Students are to follow the regular schedule for that day checking in with the teacher at the beginning of each class for attendance and direct instruction, including advisory. Each teacher will share the agenda for that class period which may include independent and/or group work and a check in with the teacher at the end of the period. There is not an expectation that students will be engaged in live interaction throughout every class period on a remote access day.

For remote learning days all assignments will be available in Google Classroom for each class.

High School Schedule

Students will follow the regular bell schedule for that day checking in with the teacher at the beginning of each class for attendance and direct instruction (no shorter than 30 minutes). Teachers will be available to students during Ram Time. Once the direct instruction part of the class is over, students may logoff, but teachers are expected to remain on to assist students.

Each teacher will post the class agenda in the Google Classroom.

Implementation of Inclement Weather Remote Plans

The Raymond Public School District will utilize the Implementation of Inclement Remote Plan Day to prevent the school year extending late into the month of June.

Implementation Plan

1. Students should be allowed to take Chromebooks home at the end of the school day if there will be a possibility of impending inclement weather that may cause a remote plan to be activated.
2. The district will make all attempts to inform parents of an Inclement Weather Remote Day the evening before implementation.
3. All remote learning assignments will be posted in each Google Classroom.
4. Students will be required to have cameras on during direct instruction.
5. We will allow 48hrs for work to be completed. In the case of internet disruptions due to weather.
6. Daily school schedules will advance in a normal progression. No repeating schedule days upon return to school.
7. In the event a teacher calls in sick during the Inclement Remote Plan Day emergency sub plans should be provided in each Google Classroom.
8. Building administrators and SAU staff will be allowed to work remotely when the district activates an Inclement Weather Remote Day.

Further Discussion

We will continue the discussion of possibly modifying the daily school schedules to limit the amount of time students screen time and increase a students ability for more check in time with staff.

I am working with the special education department to ensure we will be meeting the service needs of those students.
