C. Solar Panels _____ Action

Mr. Ledoux and I have been discussing possible options for solar panels on RHS property. To get a better idea of what may be possible, we've been working with Revision Energy, who has provided us with estimates for four different options. Projects 1 and 2

would feed into just the high school, while projects 3 and 4 would feed the grid and provide power to the entire district.
