All proposed revised policies below represent NHSBA Sample Policies in their entirety.

[BBB School Board Elections](#) (Revised)

As per NHSBA, sample policy BBB was "substantially revised to offer a more detailed process for boards when faced with a resignation."

[BEC Non-Public Session](#) (Revised)

As per NHSBA, "elements of BEC that were specific to non-public minutes were moved to sample policy BEDG such that all minutes provisions are in one comprehensive sample policy. Additional changes to BEC include language clarifying on the one hand that non-public sessions may only occur during a public meeting, on the other hand may

occur even if there is no reference on the meeting notice or agenda that such a session might occur. Final revisions include reference to Ed 303.01 directing Boards to require the presence of the Superintendent/designee at Board meetings, as well as a reminder that information discussed in non-public is confidential.”

During their review of this policy, the Policy Committee requested clarification regarding the motion to enter non-public sessions and information from NHSBA mentioned in the sample policy. See the email response from NHSBA [here](#).

[DAF Administration of Federal Grant Funds](#) (Revised)

As per NHSBA, DAF was revised “to reflect amendments to the Uniform Grant Guidance (generally 2 CFR 200), primarily regarding pre-award costs (DAF-1.F), micro-purchase limits (DAF-3.C), addition of “domestic preference” and Huawei ban (DAF-3.H), grant closeout provisions (DAF-10), and minor text and grammar corrections.”

[GBI Staff Participation in Political Activities](#) (New)

This is not a new policy to NHSBA, but it’s one that Raymond has not yet adopted. The latest revision notes for the NHSBA Sample Policy state: “the only changes are in the second to last paragraph and are intended to reflect carve out protections found in RSA 193:40 (enacted 2021) re prohibiting the teaching of discrimination; Sept. 2017, updates reflected then recent enforcement activity by the N.H. Attorney General’s Office relative to electioneering by public employees, and additional legal references.”

[IB Academic Freedom](#) (New)

This is not a new policy to NHSBA, but it’s one that Raymond has not yet adopted. The latest revision notes for the NHSBA Sample Policy state: “policy was revised to (i) include definition of academic freedom; (ii) include provisions relative to RSA 193:40 “Prohibition on Teaching Discrimination” enacted in 2021, and (iii) more directly connect policy to sample policies (a) GBI regarding staff political activities and speech, and (b) policy IMC regarding controversial speakers and programs.”
