

Ready Reading / Magnetic Reading: Key Components

- Teacher Manuals and instructional planning resources
 - Online for all teachers/interventionists to access
 - \succ Access to all grade levels
 - Printed manuals also available
 - > Presentations are available for teachers to project
- Differentiated Resources for teachers to use in small groups
 - > Teacher toolbox has differentiated activities
 - Benchmark assessment helps group students and provides pre-requisite skill lessons as well as on grade level and next step lessons
- ★ Anthology/stories for comprehension
 - Variety, text complexity/rigor appropriate for most students, interesting/engaging texts
- ★ Decodable books
 - Available, but not sure at this time how it aligns with Fundations
 - Does adhere to the Science of Reading

Ready Reading / Magnetic Reading: Student Opinion

- Fluency practice
 - Online access to passages in Teacher Toolbox
 - Opportunities for independent reading practice
- ★ Vocabulary
 - Embedded focus in student texts
- ★ Comprehension
 - ➤ Read alouds
 - Student texts
 - Student workbooks with embedded questions
- Writing component
 - ➢ 2nd & 3rd grade workbooks
 - ► K-1 grammar embedded in student workbooks
 - ▶ K-1 will need to create the curriculum- aligned to 2nd & 3rd
