Approval of Board Chair Signature ----- Action

The LRES and IHGMS SAFE (Security Action for Education) grants have been approved for funding. In order to secure the funds, the School Board Chair and the Superintendent must sign the agreements for each, to be submitted to NHED.

The SAFE grant for LRES will be used to replace the current intercom system. This system is also the mass notification system for emergencies and will include new features to make it as effective as possible. Every space in the building will be outfitted with a new speaker as well as wiring. Areas in the building that are prone to elevated noise such as the cafeteria and band room will receive amber strobe lights that will notify building users that the intercom has been activated and they need to be quiet. We will also be installing blue lockdown/panic buttons that will play a pre recorded message in the event of a violent critical incident. These buttons will also be tied into a dialer to notify dispatch that they have been activated. This system is accessible from any phone in the building and we will have two phones that tie directly into the system in the event we lose the network which our current phone system requires to operate.

The SAFE grant for the IHGMS will replace all of the current key cores and aftermarket thumb turns. They will be replaced with new key cores with a more streamlined key system. The new thumb turns will be indicator thumb turns, thus making it easier for people in the room to see locked or unlocked to lessen any confusion in the event of an emergency.
