Proposed revisions are as suggested by NHSA. The NHSBA note regarding revisions states, in part: "...revised in response to 2019 N.H. Laws Ch. 346:104 & 346:109 (HB 4). That provision, rather awkwardly written included a requirement that districts adopt specific policies regarding violations of 126-K:8, I and education on the same."

As per NHSBA: "..new policy intended to address the provisions of 2019 SB 142, adopted as 2019 Laws Chapter 252, and codified as RSA 189:16-a."
