Steve Woodward is presenting a [DRAFT of the 2019-2020 RHS Bell Schedule.](#)

Changes to the schedule are proposed for consideration because of the Board's expressed wishes to see less unstructured time for some students at Raymond High School. Under the current schedule, students who have study hall on a day when RAM time takes place could be at school for 3+ hours with our having an instructional period.

In the newly proposed schedule we have eliminated RAP (30 minutes daily) on Tuesdays - Fridays. This time was not being used constructively. We have shortened Ram Time from 83 minutes and made it more frequent during the week. Additionally, we have added an 8th period. This will create more flexibility in the schedule. However, more students will likely have a study hall, but it will not be in addition to an 83 minute Ram Time.

One of the unintended consequences may be that this draft schedule spreads our elective offerings thin. We will not know this until we spin the schedule, but do believe we can work to fix any issues that pop up.

If the Board is not prepared to authorize a change in our schedule at this time, we can keep the schedule for the upcoming school year as it is, and take more time next year to consider more significant changes to the RHS schedule.
