7:55 PM H. NHIAA Guidelines, Spring Sports Procedures _____ Action__

The NHIAA Council met via Zoom on May 13, and enacted the following:

- Regarding a vote taken at the March 19, 2021 Council meeting mandating the wearing of face masks by all participants in NHIAA spring tournament events, the Council passed the following by unanimous consent:
 - Move to recommend that masks be worn while actively participating in spring tournaments and to require that masks be worn when not actively participating and appropriate distancing cannot be maintained.

(It is recommended that masks be worn but not mandated. So if baseball and softball players are playing on the field they do not need to wear masks, when they come into the dugout they need to be put on. Track & Field they do not need to wear masks when competing in their events but when their event is finished masks need to go on.)

A few schools in our upcoming schedule are already going to the above. Our track team is at Pelham on Saturday and our MS baseball/softball play Sanborn next week. Both schools have already stated that they will be following the new recommendation.

This agenda item has been added to determine if we still compete with those schools not wearing masks and if we will require/ask them to follow our protocol?

8:05 PM I. Policy IO Class Size _____ Discussion

A Board member has requested discussion of [this Policy](#). Additionally, the question was asked, "How many students at RHS wanted an honors course but did not get it this year?" According to the RHS Guidance Department there were 6 students who wanted a specific honors course but did not take the course. It is important to note that there is no record of why the decision was made (ex. Scheduling challenge vs reconsidering if honors level coursework was truly desired).

There was also an inquiry about the process for Honors by Exhibition, or contracting to earn honors, while in a College and Career Ready Class. [The form/process is included here.](#)

Right now there is one small group of (two) students who are in Embedded Honors and meeting with the teacher after school. This is atypical, prompted by necessity after the schedule changed on April 19th.

[JICDA Student Safety and Violence Prevention](#) (Call Letters Correction)

The proposed revision for policy JICDA is to update the call letters to “JICK” to match the New Hampshire School Boards Association coding system. After this change is approved, we will update all references to JICDA in other policies and district documents to “JICK.”

[ACAC Sexual Harassment Policy and Grievance Process](#) (New Policy)

From NHSBA: This new policy is intended to replace former samples JBAA and GBAA. This policy is intended to reflect the requirements of new federal regulations pertaining to Title IX of the Education Amendments Act of 1972. In general, the new regulations impose several procedural steps in responding to sexual harassment, create a new definition of sexual harassment, and require a district to respond promptly, equitably (to complainants and “respondents” (alleged perpetrators)), and in a manner that is not deliberately indifferent whenever it has actual knowledge of sexual harassment in an educational program or activity of the District.
