*Pat Arsenault will be in attendance to explain [some suggested revisions](#) to the new Before School Program that will begin at LRES next year. There are two main reasons why we are asking the Board to consider an adjustment to the tuition rate. First, we very recently learned that the YMCA provides scholarships to some students in financial need. Second, we have been advised that if we lower the tuition rate we may be able to expand the program and serve more families. Therefore, if we lower our rates, and are consequently able to expand the program, more revenue will be created and more children can ultimately be served.
