- Promethean Boards. Matt Clifton has supplied me with a quote for 20

 boards to do throughout the district to outfit every classroom, including special
 education and preschool.
- 2. Air conditioning for the RHS English wing. We've received a quote for \$88,000 for this work.
- 3. Radios. (Communication radios for certain district employees, to replace the current old radios.) I am awaiting a quote from Todd Ledoux to determine an approximate cost for this.

	"Moving some of our board meetings has increased the time between meetings. We have three weeks at the end of May to our meeting in June. We have a couple of options and I know we will be discussing the hiring process at our next board meeting. We can have several short non-public meetings to hire. We can have them during the day or evening. Our attorney has stated we can do all the hiring in non-public and this would alleviate the need for a 30 minute public input requirement. I have asked other districts as to what they do at the end of the school year and during the summer. They authorize the Superintendent to hire and then bring the individuals forward to have the board "rubber stamp" the hires. By law the board needs to approve the hiring/nominations. We can also just go with the scheduled meeting but I do worry we will lose some individuals. We can't stop anybody from leaving but most people will stop looking once they have that signed contract."

Below are policies being brought to the Board so they may be updated for inclusion in next year's student handbooks.

ILD Non-Educational Questionnaires, Surveys, & Research (Revised)

From NHSBA (2018 notes): Prior to the 2017 amendment to RSA 186:11, XI-d, the notice and previous "opt-out" requirements of the state law were found in NHSBA sample policy ILDA. With the 2017 amendments, the similarities between the state and federal statutes were greater than their differences, and NHSBA determined to combine the requirements into one policy. As such, we have modified sample policy ILD to identify some of remaining differences between the applicable state and federal statutes, and to reconcile the resulting overlap between former ILD and ILDA. NHSBA adoption consideration: Districts should be sure that in adopting the modified ILD they simultaneously repeal policy ILDA (or its equivalent).

ILD-R Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment - Supporting Forms (Redact)

There is no corresponding NHSBA sample policy.

JIH Student Searches and Their Property (Revised)

Proposed changes are recommended to match our policy to the current NHSBA sample policy.

JIH-R Search of Students (Revised)

Proposed changes are recommended to match our policy to the current NHSBA sample policy.

JKAA Use of Restraints and Seclusion (Revised)

From NHSBA (2023 notes): "Substantial revisions and reformatting throughout. The impetus for revision was the 2023 passage of SB179 and HB491, both amending provisions of RSA 126-U. SB179 refined the definition of seclusion, and added a requirement for use of 'co-regulators'..... Sections also added to sample policy relative to mandated reporting for violations of RSA 126-U, and review of IEPs, 504 plans, behavior intervention plans, or other such invidualized plans following use of restraint or seclusion."

JJA Student Activities and Organizations (Revised)

From NHSBA (2022 notes): NHSBA revised JJA generally to better align with sample JJJ (also revised) relating to participation by home and non-enrolled district students in district courses, programs and activities. Included in the substantial revisions to JJA is a requirement that the Principal have direct responsibility to make determinations as to home/non-enrolled district students meeting eligibility requirements. This is intended to help ensure equitable application of eligibility standards.

JICJ Personal Communications Devices (Revised)

It was recommended by administration to change our general use of the term "extra-curricular" to "co-curricular" throughout our policies for consistency, as well as to emphasize the equal importance of these activities as part of our academic offerings. Policy JICJ is in our handbook, which is why this change is coming to you this evening. You will see a few more policies at upcoming meetings with similar proposed revisions.
