IHAM Health Education and Exemption from Instruction

From NHSBA, revisions to IHAM are "... intended to (1) more directly connect requirements for education about sexually transmitted diseases (previously found in policy IHAMC/GBGAA/JLCCA) into health education provisions, (2) adding language distinguishing parental opt-out of health education based upon religious reasons (RSA 186:11, IX-b) from opt-out process for other "objectionable course material" as spelled out in policy IGE, and (3) clarifying the inspection right/process"

From NHSBA: "NHSBA revised GBGA as part of a health policy overhaul with assistance from the NH School Nurses Association. The changes to GBGA are minor, generally updating language to reflect current terminology and practice."
