Raymond School District Policy - BDA

BOARD ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING

At the next regularly scheduled School Board meeting, following the second session of School District meeting (RSA 40:13), the new School Board shall organize and elect its officers from its own members. This meeting shall be called to order by the School Board Member who most recently served as Chairperson, who shall preside until the election of a Chairperson. If the Chairperson loses his/her election or does not run for re-election, the Vice-Chairperson shall serve as Chair during the organizational meeting. In the event there are no officers at the annual organizational meeting, the Superintendent shall preside until the Chairperson is elected.

Officers shall be elected in the following order; chairperson, vice-chairperson and secretary. Each officer shall serve for a period of one year, and is eligible for re-election as an officer. All nominations (a second is not required) for each position will made prior to voting. Each nominee will be voted on in the order in which the nomination was made. Voting for any of the three above mentioned officers shall continue until a nominee receives a majority of votes for the position to be filled.

Vacancies in the above mentioned offices occurring during the year shall be filled by the School Board at its discretion.
