Venue Regulations:

- ❖ 6 people per table spaced 6 feet apart.
- ❖ Masks must be worn while entering and exiting the building.
- ❖ Masks must be worn while going to the bar for a drink and to the restrooms.
- ❖ State mandate about dancing suggests that groups over 100 wear masks or face coverings.

Raymond School District Regulations (per 2020-21 Reopening Plan):

- ❖ Use of Face Coverings: “Required at all times on-site indoors, on the school bus, and outdoors when social distancing is not possible. Exceptions: eating or drinking when 6 feet apart or during mask break.”
- ❖ Social Distancing: “Students and employees will be required to abide by 3 to 6 foot social distancing (goal of 6 foot). Student desks will be placed 3-6 feet apart, with a goal of 6 feet. 6 foot markers will be placed where lines usually form. The direction of foot traffic in hallways will be visually indicated. In grades 6 and up, class dismissals will be staggered to limit the number of students in the hallways at one time. Students will remain on buses until called to enter school, and dismissed to buses from classrooms. Multiple building entrances/exits will be used. There will be no indoor group or ensemble singing.”
- ❖ Daily Screening for Illness: “All students who attend on-site will engage in a full screening, including a temperature screening, daily upon arrival to the building.”

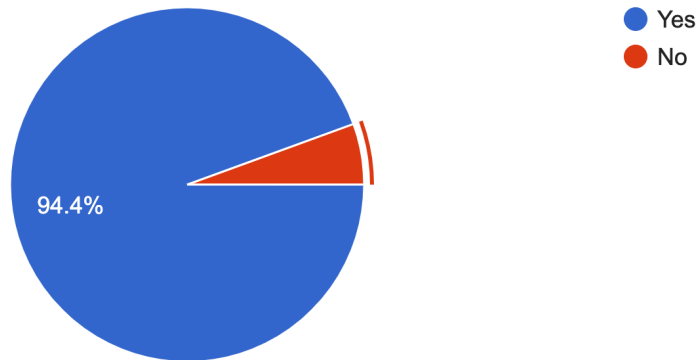
Student Behavior Contract:

- ❖ Students may be required to sign a contract that states specified rules regarding social distancing and the wearing of masks or face coverings. A prom attendee who chooses not to follow these rules will be asked to leave after enforcement of the three-strike rule as followed by the building administrators at RHS.
- ❖ Persons responsible for enforcement of rules and regulations: building administrators, adult chaperones, and the on-duty Manchester Police Officer.

Student Survey Results:

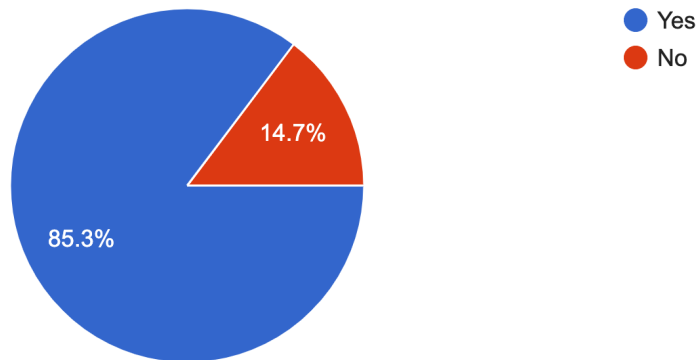
Are you interested in attending a senior prom?

36 responses



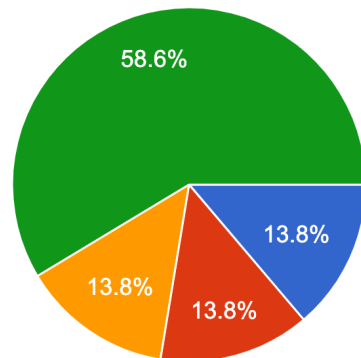
If you are interested, would you be bringing a guest?
